One of our clients is an older gentleman with significant heart problems. He has no living family members so he considers his cat, Jelly Bean, his only family. When his long-time Pet Patrol volunteer dropped off the food and litter for Jelly Bean last weekend, our client followed the volunteer to the door and started to cry. He told her that he was scheduled for some outpatient surgery on Monday and wanted the volunteer to promise him that if he did not come out of the surgery Jelly Bean would not be put to sleep. She reminded him that part of the mission of The Pet Patrol is to find new homes for our clients' pets when necessary. She assured him that she would personally make sure that Jelly Bean got a new home if something happened to him. The volunteer checked in with him the night before and the day after his surgery and he is doing fine. In fact, he and Jelly Bean were on the couch having lunch and watching TV together. Apparently, Jelly Bean has favorite shows.

My elderly client, Sarah, fell and broke her leg. The surgery was successful but Sarah will need to be in a care facility for the next couple of months since she lives alone, with the exception of her cat, Noodles. When I called the Nursing Home to see how she was doing after her surgery, Sarah's greatest concern was Noodles. Although a neighbor feeds the cat every day, my client misses her terribly and worries about her. Since the cat cannot visit Sarah, I decided that once a week I would take Sarah to visit Noodles. With permission from the doctor, I borrowed a wheelchair and a walker and enlisted a friend to help me get Sarah in and out of my tiny car. Although Noodles was shy at first, she was eventually very happy to see Sarah and spend several hours in her lap while my friend and I cleaned up Sarah's kitchen and did some laundry for her. We also cleaned up the area where she fell and broke her leg. Who else is going to do it?

It has been three weeks and every week I have picked Sarah up, brought her home, organized some fresh laundry for her and enjoyed watching her play with Noodles. I am a busy person but it is worth every minute of my time to see Sarah and Noodles together. If something happens to Sarah, I have a friend who has agreed to take Noodles. This and the weekly visits have done more than any medicine in the world can do for Sarah.
