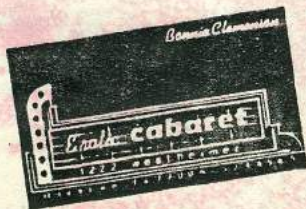

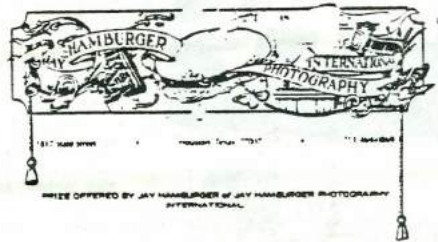
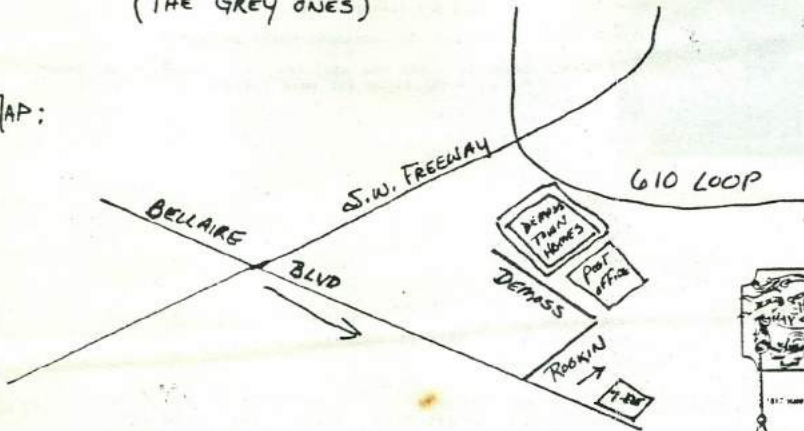

## APOLOGIES

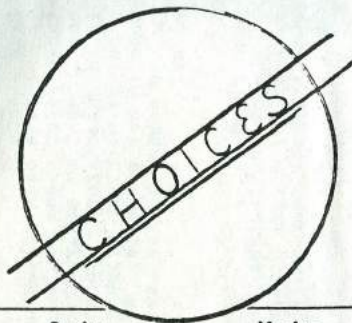
Mindy - I need that calendar!

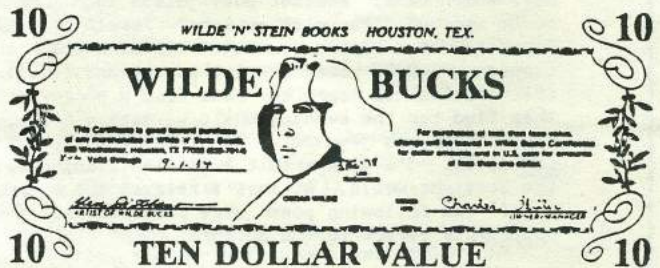
