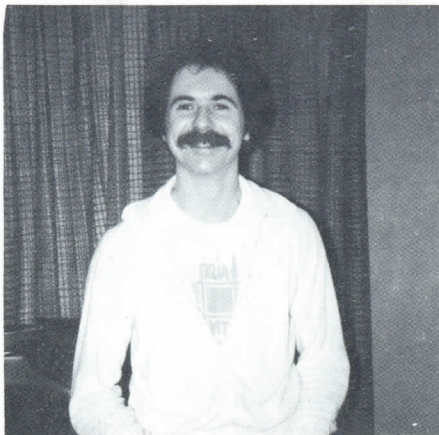

## Fun Anytime, But A Must on St. Patrick's Day

Have you ever been to a 234 year old seaport? No? Well you should visit historic Savannah. Located on Georgia's golden coast, Savannah offers much for visitors, as well as locals, especially when spring arrives with its flowers, magnificent weather and the Annual Sara Awards!

Savannah, Georgia's first capital, located 276 miles from Atlanta, 108 from Charleston and 159 from Jacksonville, is probably America's most unusual city. General James Oglethorpe, Savannah's founder, laid a plan of avenues and parks which over the years has expanded to a total of

32 squares in the downtown area. Squares are located every two blocks north-south and east-west giving the average tourist a large headache. But if one happens to be in Savannah during the spring, one never complains—just marvels at the beauty of the azalea lined drives and squares with thousands upon thousands of beautifully colored plants.

Spring is also time for Savannah's Irish population to stage their annual St. Patrick's parade. This day the city, especially the downtown area, bubbles with excitement. It's next to impossible to get into the historic area (the largest historical preservation in the U.S.) during the morning of the parade:

If you are a Southerner, you are sure to meet a friend, past or present. Hospitality during this week is unbelievable. If you are breathing you will usually find yourself invited to one of the many rounds of parties that both the gay and straight groups are giving. Miss Ellis promises that there is something here for everyone and you should be able to find something to your likes and desires among the tens of thousands of bewildered and often hung tourists.

Savannah's gays rise to the occasion by insisting that many out-of-town-

ers stay in their townhouses, giving them parties at the drop of a hat pin. Let me mention at this time that rooms are at a premium the week of St. Patrick's. This year it happens to fall between March 14 and 19, with the parade on the 17th and the gay's big party, the Annual Sara Awards, on Saturday, the 19th. You should pick up Ma Bell and dial a friend, hotel or someone you've met at the bookstore to find a place to park your tired ass. Motels are now almost full until parade day with a gradual thinning out towards Saturday. I do not recommend coming without prior arrangements for some type of lodging.

Since I'm giving recommendations, let me give a few more. Weather here is usually quite warm during middle March, but just in case, bring a sweater. Restaurants in Savannah are nationally known. There are even some who leave you enough money to visit one of the local gay bars. Try the Pirates House for a medium priced meal. There's also the Pink House whole bar located in the basement is popular with local gays. They have double fireplaces going winter and summer and it's a treat for straight's or gays. If you like seafood, and who in their right mind doesn't, you can try Tasse's Pier, located on the historic Wilmington River. The hotel restaurants are also good. Try the DeSoto Hilton, the Downtowner or the Holiday Inn. Do not plan to stay at the Downtowner however. The folks there aren't overly friendly to gays after an incident a few years back. That year some 250 of the 280 rooms were occupied by sisters. Needless to say with that many sisters one is bound to find some excitement and what the straight guests found were 500 drunk queens dangling over the iron railings, etc. I would recommend either the Holiday Inn or the John Wesley. The latter is across from the Pink

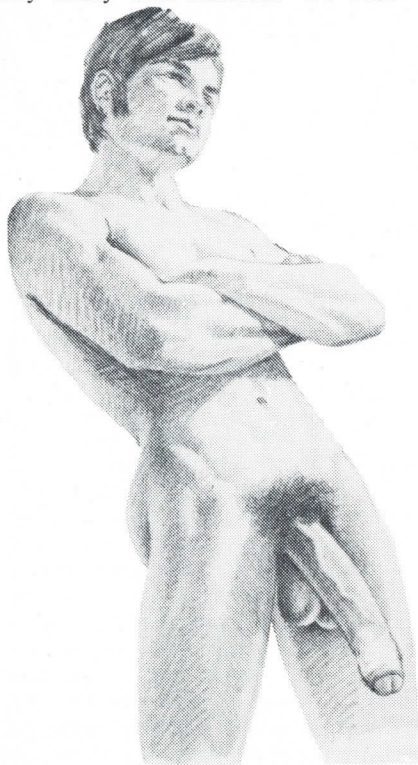
was 1962 in the South and there weren't any blacks at Jackson County or I might have been in for a real treat.

"My dick," he replied. "Your hole's so tight it's pulling back the skin on my dick." And with that he backed off and pulled out.

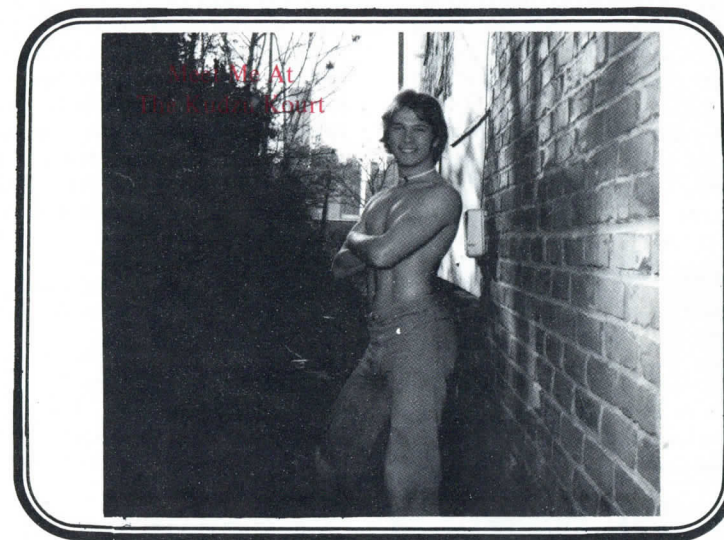
"Come on," put it back in," I begged. I was all excited now and wanted to do more.

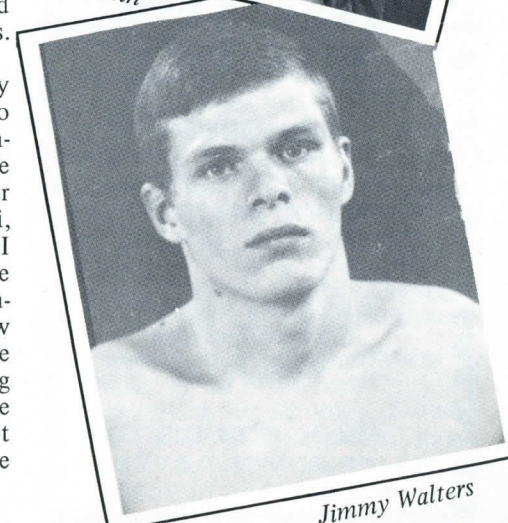

The purpose of this type of reload was to have a long single that could be recorded on one disc without loss of quality or loudness. If the song was recorded on a standard 7" 45 disc, the grooves would be too close together, causing extremely low volume, not enough bass plus feed back.

Record manufactures initially made the 12" disco disc for the disco clubs. Now record companies have decided to market the 12" disco product so you, the retail customer, can purchase your favorite disco mix in full length.

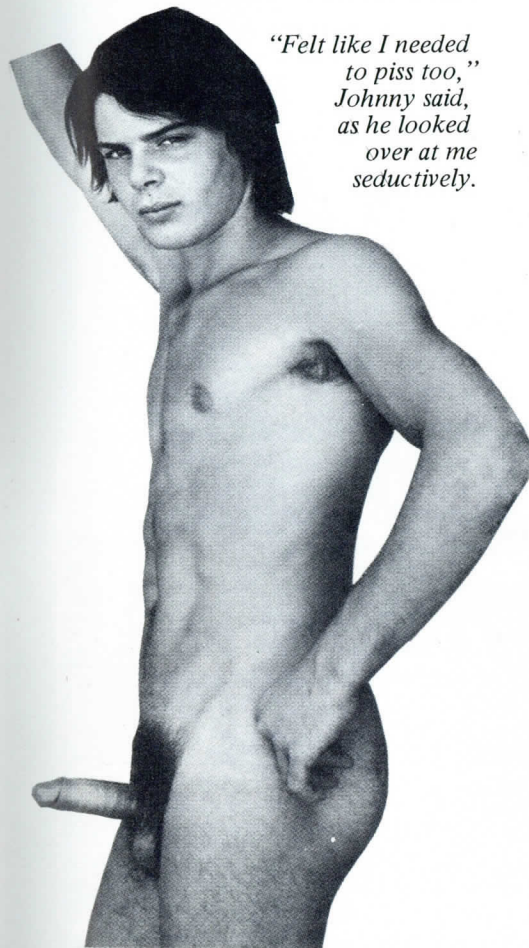
