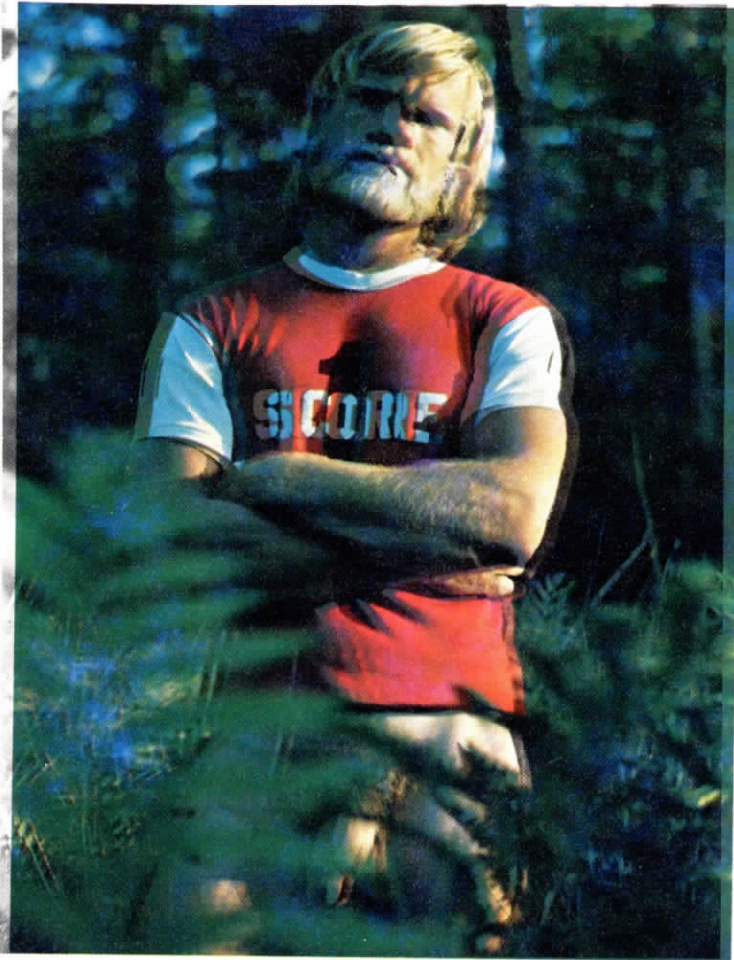

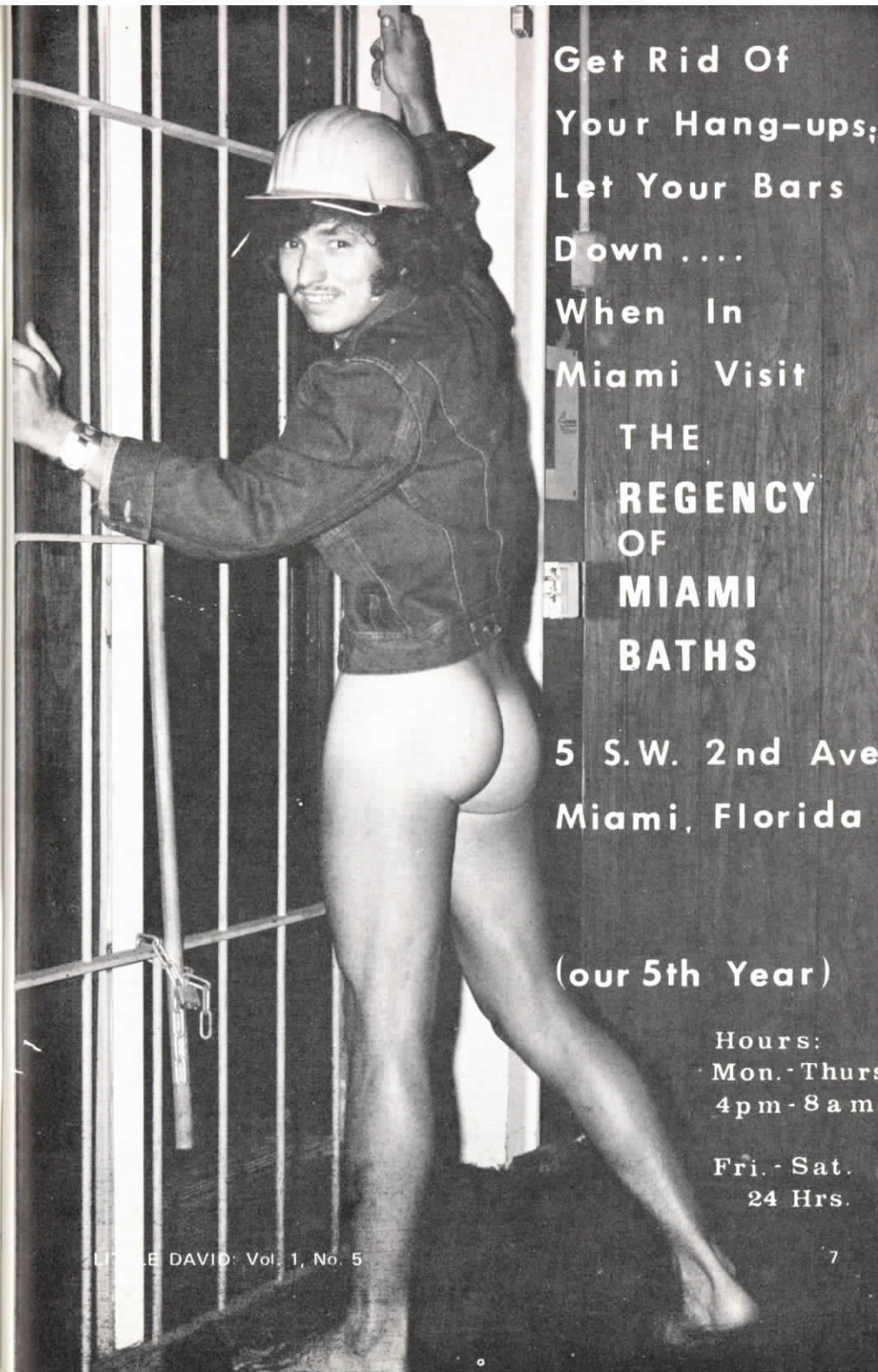

NEW YORK

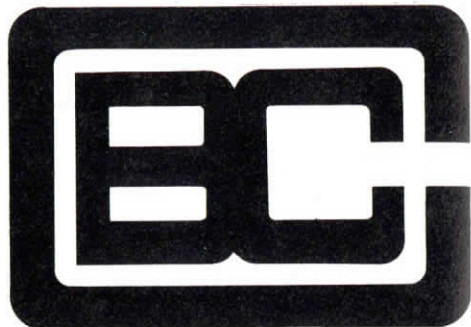

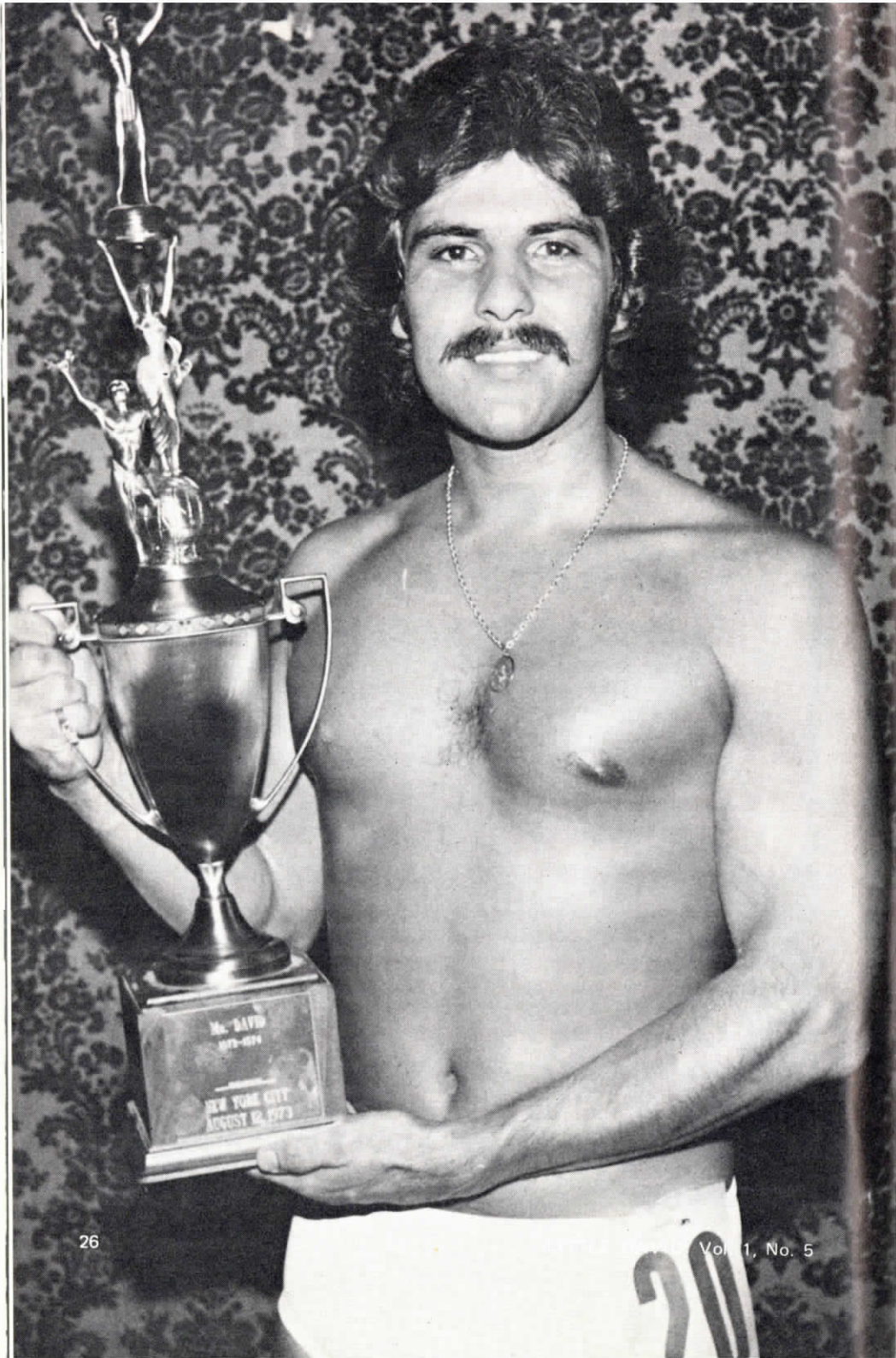

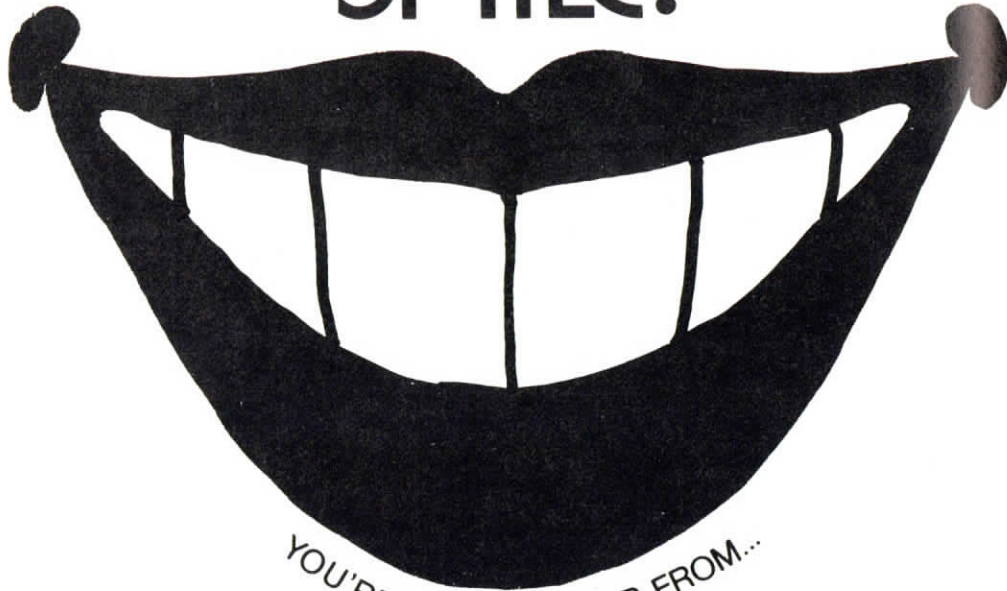
in broad daylight (behind the barn): "It's a Cock! Wanna see one up close?" I did.

for good behavior") clustered at sunrise to "greet the day with a smile" and "do kind deeds." I did it better making hay on the horse trail, time in the garden, and points over the back fence: men knew me on sight. "Watch out, (a handsome chef said) "he can spot a Cock on the range in a grease fire!" It was true. Like a hawk, I'd developed the extraordinary ability to snag a bird "no bigger than a midgits crotch." The Audubon Society trembled, game wardens took note, feather pluckers gasped. I was flying high.

Sometimes (quite often) in the middle of the night, I creaped outside to see "the lay of the land" (behind the barn). A nature lover at heart, I thrilled (became emotional) when the secrets in the bushes exposed themselves over the shadows in the weeds. Twigs cracked, (like a pair of old joints) the wind hustled the leaves from high hung places, and a low, almost mad, groan carried across the dirt path into the grass. Exhausted, breathless, (stripped to the soul) I saw the sun lick the horizon, swoon against the clouds, and slip through the darkness. suspicion. Every move I made was watched (and I moved madly). Strangers appeared in unexpected places (behind the bushes, in the shadows, under the bed): the picks were digging for dirt. I had nothing to hide, but a few old records (kept by the police). Everywhere I turned a question followed: "Who ya doin' in the barn, queenie!" I was shocked. Slowly, I began to realize the truth. It wasn't my reputation that was being investigated, only my morals! As though I were some kind of a tramp, the persecution continued, grew, spread. I was hunted, secretly (like a Cock in the dark).

I never stopped thinking, planning, (cruising). Wheels turned, bells rang, drums rolled; intellectual ideas sprung from nowhere, exploded (full blown) and stuck (ram rod hard) in the fathoms of my mind: every man I saw gave me an idea. I was obsessed. Frustration lurked in the shadows, leapt from the shrubbery, stumbled across the dirt path, in broad daylight (behind the barn). I saw visions, heard voices, felt vibrations. Clearly, I was no longer the innocent young boy I once was: I had become a genius. The impact was immediate, devastating, sensational. Men stood up and stared when I ran naked through the grass (or laughed in the toilet). Hidden glances groped deeper than the eye could see, gestures betrayed passion with a single finger, words crept into adlib speeches (many listed in the dictionary): exhibitionist, schizophrenic, looney-fruit. Overnight, I became the central attraction, the main event, (and a three ring side show!).

Ignoring the controversy, I turned my talent toward a much neglected intellectual pursuit (unheard of in less scholarly circles): Cock Conservation. Alone, unaided by Federal

grants, Government subsidies, state loans, (or county contributions) I struggled, incognito (from hand to mouth) erecting a program protecting a vanishing species. It was a labor of love.

Everything was against me: the times, the place, (and the law). I rose above it, became a scientific recluse, and plotted the advancement of an organization which would change the scope in conservationist theory. Abhorring the impersonal, traditional methods practiced by the pseudo-professionals, I chose a system known for years (in tea rooms, bus stations, and parks): the P.P. (penetrating proposition). It worked like a charm, spread like wild fire, (caught on like the clap). Welding together the need for intimacy and "friendly relations" I called my newly baptized association the Society Under Constant Kare. Weary, I returned expecting the worst; instead, incredibly, I discovered I was famous!

Three post cards (from a mental institution) suggested I "join the group;" a cleverly worded letter (written by the American Psychiatric Association) asked for "permission to study your head;" and a note, scribbled in crayon, begged me to send "a lock of hair, an article of clothing, and one tooth."

I was touched. Determined not to disappoint my frantic fans, I immediately made plans for a world wide tour, which included China, Paris (Pennsylvania), and Fire Island. The travel agent called the police.

Fame is complicated. Midnight journeys along moonridden, grass filled paths, shrouded by shrubbery, surrounded in shadows (the natural roost of the Cock) became almost impossible. Furthermore, there was an obvious lack of reality concerning the position to which I had recently arisen: did anyone tell Einstein to "sweep the floor or I'll break your arm?" I protested. Minutes later I was in trouble for "acting funny in the shower." Surely, something was wrong.

the eye of the storm, the center of the tornado, (and the middle of a mess). It started with an elementary experiment concerning: a tape measure, an ice cube, and a jar of strawberry jam. 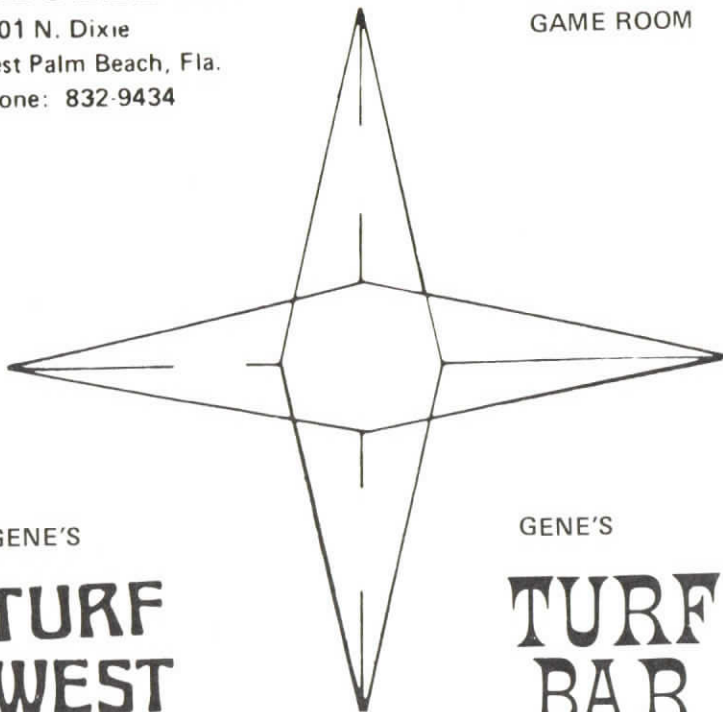

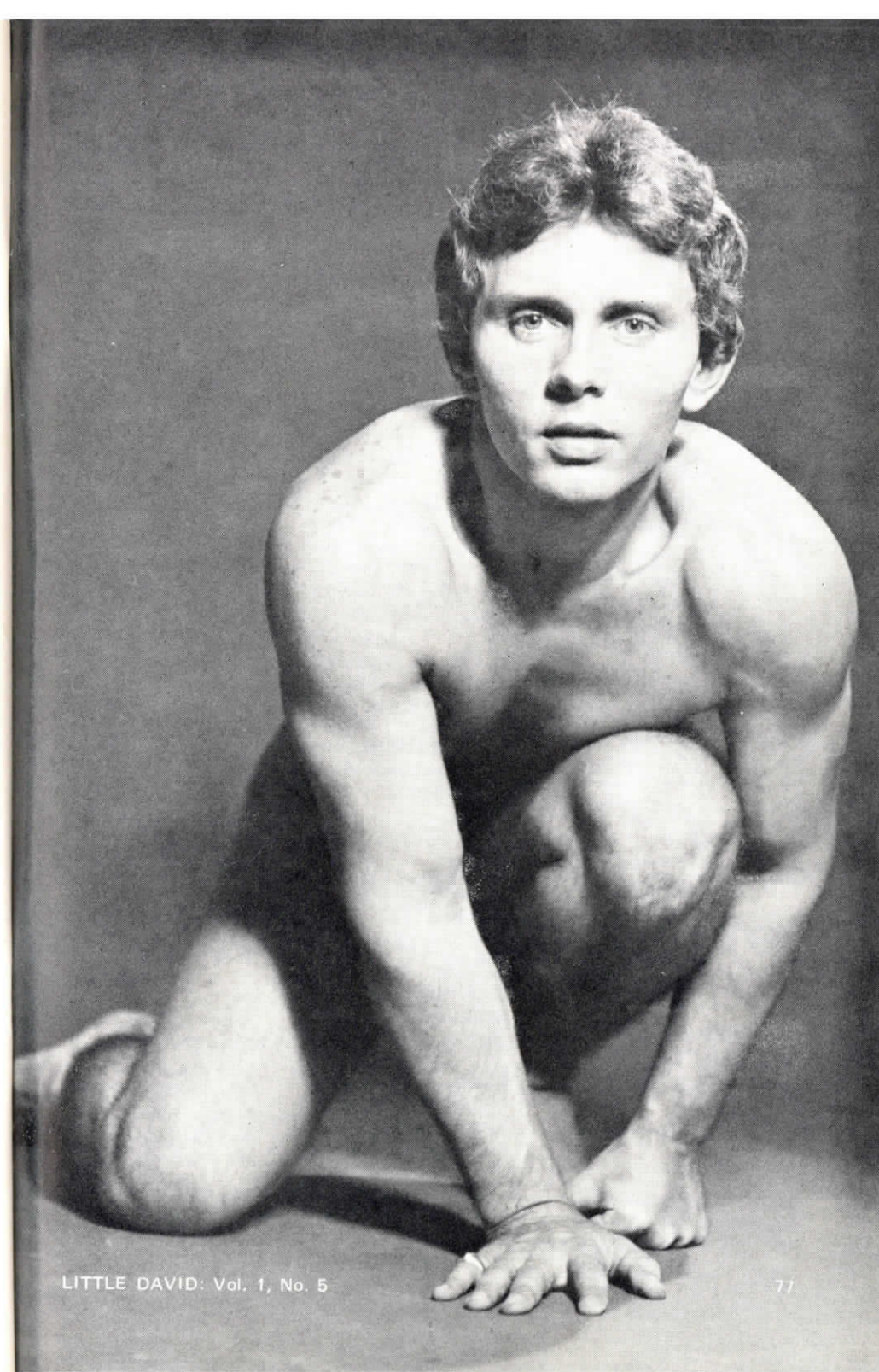

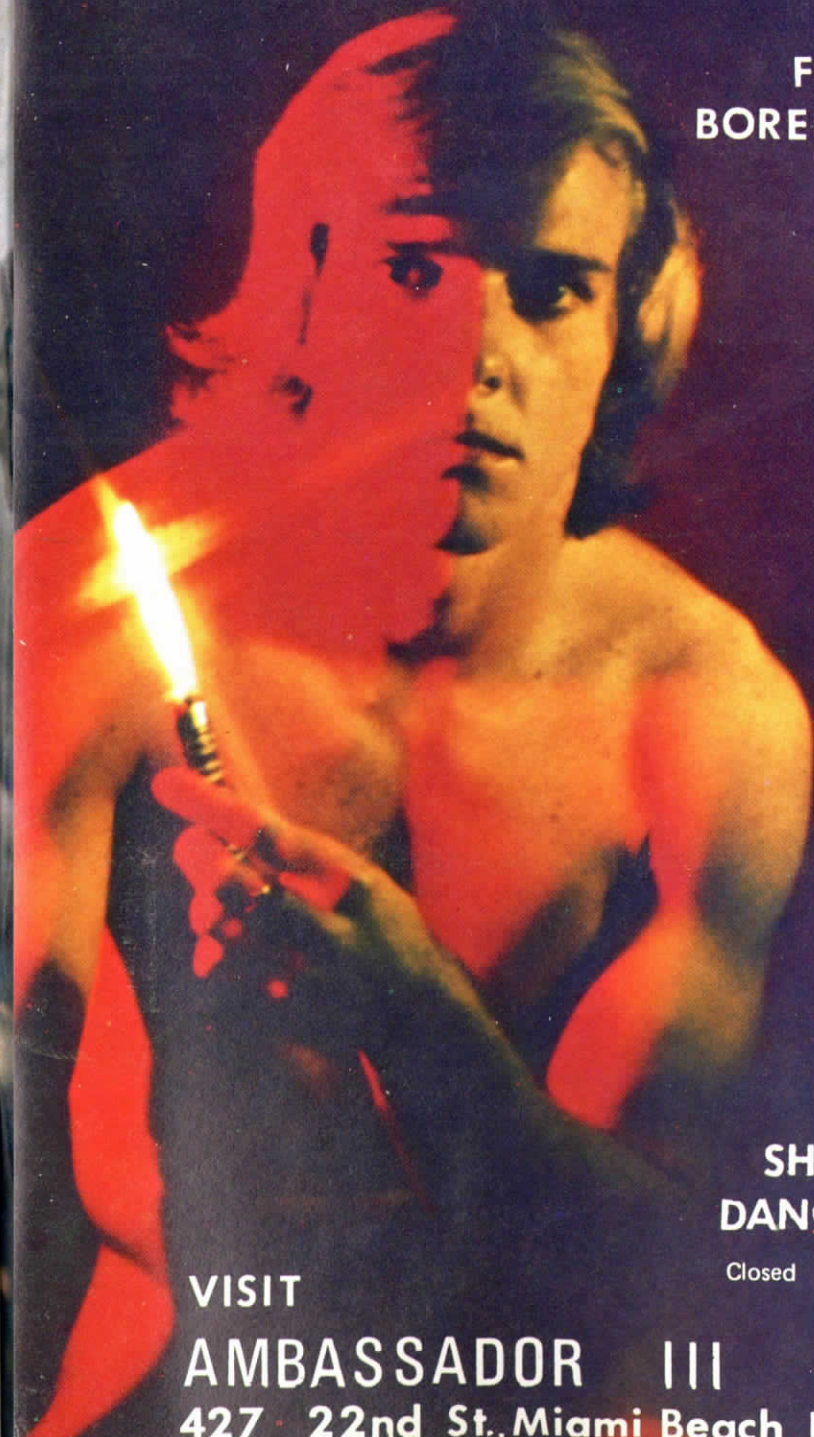
