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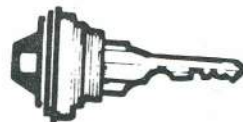
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# Radio Gay Houston

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# City Council Adopts Porn Standards

**City Council** has unanimously adopted a statement written by the **Greater Houston Clergy Association** defining what it calls community standards on what constitutes pornography.

Although the statement has no legal force, **Mayor Jim McConn** said it presages development of an anti-pornography ordinance, which the city legal department is expected to submit to council this summer.

A federal judge nullified a previous anti-pornography ordinance on the grounds that it was vague, too broad and tried to eliminate, not regulate, establishments selling explicit sexual books and films.

**Rev. Dr. Albert Walling**, president of the clergy association, praised **McConn** and council after the statement was adopted Wednesday, February first.

The statement puts council on record as opposing the sale or display of pornographic materials in stores, movie houses or other public places.

Here is the statement which council adopted:

"Sec. 1: That the **City Council** hereby adopts the statement of community standards promulgated by the community standards committee of the **Greater Houston Clergy Association** which statement reads as follows:

"We oppose the sale and showing or displaying of obscene and pornographic materials in stores and shops of our community. We also object to the showing of obscene and pornographic films in movie houses, arcades of book stores, hotels or motels and any other public place in our community.

"We understand the word *obscene* to mean as Webster's dictionary defines it: offensive to modesty or decency; lewd; disgusting, filthy, repulsive (language, conduct, remarks, pictures, acts).

"We understand the word *pornography* (from Greek *porne*, a prostitute) to mean as Webster defines it: having the nature of pornography, obscene.

"We find particularly objectionable the displays which include but are not limited to the following:

"Public portrayal of:

- "1. Acts of oral or anal copulation (sodomy).
  - "2. Juvenile or adult masturbation (male or female).
  - "3. Sado-masochistic acts.
  - "4. Any lewd exhibition of the genitals such as depictions of male erections.
  - "5. Child molestation.
  - "6. Male homosexual acts or lesbianism.
  - "7. Acts of incest.
  - "8. Males or females copulating with animals (bestiality).
  - "9. Any other displays of sexual perversion.
  - "10. Acts of intercourse publicly portrayed.
- "We find such public display of sexuality offensive, below our moral standards and we believe below the community standards of the majority of citizens of **Houston, Texas.**"

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## Dignity Writes Pope

The Gay Roman Catholics of **Dignity, Inc.**, have sent an open telegram to **Pope Paul** asking him to "speak out equally in behalf of the civil and human rights of Roman Catholic homosexual persons according to the norms of **Vatican II** and the recent **Vatican** declaration on human sexuality."

**Walter Kay**, president of the international Catholic group, hopes the telegram will stir the **Pope** to some type of public response, publicly repudiating the activities and statements of the **Catholic Bishops of Wichita**. "I pledge that the 6,000 members of **Dignity**, predominantly Roman Catholic, will cooperate with other groups in the **United States** dedicated to preserving human and civil rights, and to work to insure that anti-homosexual bigots are not successful in their attempts to undermine the **United States** constitution.

The bishop of **Wichita**, **David Maloney**, has declared that he will not obey a city ordinance granting civil rights to Gay people. The letter to **Pope Paul** began by praising him for his recent "heroic offer" to exchange his life for those hostages held by terrorists in the **Middle East**. The letter further supported the **Pope's** statements discouraging the "reactionary and anti-Vatican II beliefs of **Archbishop Lefevre** in his attempt to lead Catholics astray and back into the Middle Ages."

The anti - "pornography" forces in Houston are back in action (See related article page 5) attempting to spread their idea of community standards to everybody's community. And chances are the High Priestess of the Smut Stompers, **Geneva Kirk Brooks**, is touching up her makeup to stage a comeback sometime soon.

**Geneva Brooks** is an admitted homophobe who once "forgot" her opposition to pornography in the process of preparing a news release: She quoted from a short story in "**Hustler**" magazine to illustrate an anti-Gay statement.

She ran in the recent school board election and will probably try to run again.

**LATE BREAKING NOTE:** On the Wednesday night Wilde-stein radio program, host Raymond Hill proceeded to "go off on" Houston police chief Harry Caldwell. Hill stated that Chief Caldwell's public image as a "smart cop" was a cover-up for below average intelligence. He stated that the Chief and the police force were the mos

stated that the Chief and the police force "were the mos overpaid unskilled labor force in the city". He charged that Caldwell participated in illegal police intelligence activities under a previous administration.

## CITY CLERK COMES OUT

Seattle city clerk **Wayne Angevine** revealed his homosexuality to illustrate a point when he was presented a citizens initiative to repeal a law protecting homosexuals from job discrimination.

"Someone has to come out and start explaining us to the public," **Angevine** said. "We have to start telling people that we aren't just a lot of weirdos in skirts and lipsticks. We're everyone - the mailman, the guy who runs the corner drug store, the policeman - statistically, at least three out of every 20 people you see on the street and probably more," said **Angevine**.

The initiative was filed by police officer **David Estes** who said that he opposes homosexuality on religious grounds and wants to lead a drive to gather 17,600 signatures to force an election on the subject.

"I believe the laws of **God** don't change," **Estes** said. "And it is clearly stated in the Bible that homosexual conduct is wrong."

**Angevine** says that he expects some negative reactions to his coming out. "There will be some strange looks at City Hall and some crank phone calls. . ."

Here in **Houston**, the response is a little more destructive. **Gary Van Ootegham** lost his job in the **Harris County** comptroller's office after he came out publicly.

**Angevine** claims that he was "the perfect closet homosexual" until about five years ago. "I did everything that was expected of me. . .got married, had children." His marriage broke up after his first homosexual contacts five years ago.

## Lesbian Convention Set

A founding convention of the **National Lesbian Organization** is set for March 17-19 in **Los Angeles**. Following the success of the lesbian resolution at **IWY** in **Houston**, energy has been running high, and convention organizers feel "it is time to move and establish a structure to push forward with plans of action to achieve our goals." One hundred representatives will be chosen according to geographic regions and the "relative amount of known lesbian political activity in that area." ## Gay Lutherans to Convene

The first national convening of the members of **Lutherans Concerned** has been scheduled for July 7, 8 and 9 in **Milwaukee, Wisconsin**.

**Assembly '78** is being billed by organizers as "an opportunity for worship, workshops, speakers and decisions about **Lutherans Concerned**." The site and dates were chosen with an eye to the national convention of the three million-member **Lutheran Church in America**, which will be held the following week in **Chicago**. **Chicago** itself was bypassed as site-of-choice for **Assembly '78** out of respect for the boycott called by the **National Council of Churches** and the **National Organization for Women**. The boycott is aimed at the economics of all 15 states that have not yet ratified the **Equal Rights Amendment**.

**Lutherans Concerned** was founded almost 4 years ago as an organization of Gay and non-Gay people, pastors and laypeople from the **Lutheran Church**. It has chapters in 20 American cities.

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## HOUSTON BOYCOTT

In **Houston**, the **COORS** boycott is doing quite well. It is apparent that one of the five **Houston** area **Coors** distributors is facing the loss of his distributorship due to declining sales attributed to the boycott. It is expected that his territory, which includes **Montrose**, will be split among the remaining four distributors. The drop in sales has occurred not only in **Bars**, but also in local supermarkets.

The **COORS** boycott began several months ago in this area after a decision was made at the **National Gay Leadership Conference** held last August in **Denver, Colorado** to endorse and support the boycott. This joined an effort by the **Brewery Workers Union** in initiating a national boycott. Union members were objecting to unreasonable hiring and personnel practices. Of importance to the Gay community was the adamant refusal by **COORS** to include a clause in the **Brewery Workers** contract assuring non-discrimination for reasons of sexual or affectional preference. Gay leaders also voted to demand that **COORS** cease advertising in those publications which invariably took a negative position on the Gay Rights issue.

Locally, the **Houston Gay Political Caucus** voted to support the recommended boycott. Recently, **COORS** representatives offered to fund a \$50,000 research program on the attitudes of **Houstonians** toward Gay people to be done by the **University of Houston** in an attempt to end the boycott in **Houston**. This offer was rejected at the last meeting of the **Gay Political Caucus** as an attempted "buy-off" of the Gay community. It was felt that while information gained from such a study would be useful, its benefit would not offset the evil of discriminatory hiring practices on the part of **COORS**.

It was the sense of the caucus that its membership should not only support the boycott, but should actively encourage it among retailers and consumers.

# Disco Grandma

If you go to the Disco bars, chances are you've met or seen the short, silver-haired lady with the warm, dazzling smile. Like all the other familiar faces at the bars, "Disco Grandma" goes where the crowd is to dance, party, and be with the people she loves: the Houston Gay community. She participated in the Human Rights rally January 8th. "I was standing on the podium with Ray (Hill)", she says proudly.

Disco Grandma got her name when Ernestine, a drag queen, approached her during a show and asked her who she was. Leary of releasing her real name to a large audience (as she still is - she will not allow it to be printed), she recalled a name her son's lover had jokingly given her that day. "I'm Disco Grandma," she said.

It was her son and his lover of seventeen years (whom she refers to as her son-in-law) who first brought D.G. to the bars back in June of 1977. She wasn't sure how people would react to her, and her son assured her that she would be accepted. She was surprised to find herself instantly accepted and loved. "That first night I went out. . .there was this young boy who had recently lost his grandmother. We sat out in front of the Old Plantation and talked for hours.

"I guess I'd be rich if I could have a five dollar bill for every time some boy told me he'd give anything in the world if his mother or grandmother had been like me. I love these kids, they're my life. I wouldn't trade places with anyone in the world."

What was her reaction when her son told her that he was Gay? "He didn't have to tell me," she says, "I knew. My son and I have always been very close, as we still are." Since she started going out with her son and son-

in-law, she says, there has been an even tighter, more open and loving relationship between the three.

Disco Grandma rarely has to pay for her own drink. "They usually get to my table before I do!" she says, referring, of course, to the stage-side table she reserves every Sunday for the drag show at the Old Plantation. She was also once told by the manager of the Midnit Sun that she would not be allowed to pay for drinks there.

Disco Grandma is the adopted family of many Gay whose own families have turned away from them. She gets calls from friends every day who report to her the problems, interests, fears, joys, and heartbreaks. And she always listens with an understanding ear. She once told Gay activist Ray Hill that there should be some kind of an organization to teach people to love each other.

What the world does need are more honest, loving people like Disco Grandma. She sets an example that could keep others from being disillusioned about love and human nature. She accepted others and was accepted in return. She's the kind of person that you want to tell, "Thank you very much for being who and what you are."

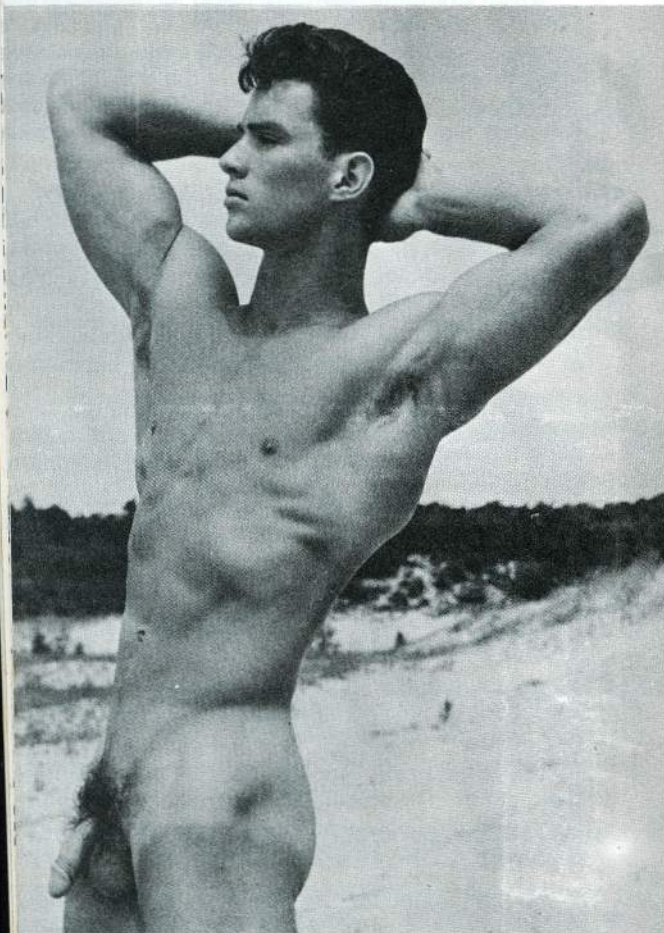
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## RAY HILL ARRESTED

Early this week, Gay activist Ray Hill was taken into custody by four uniformed officers of the Houston Police Department. The arrest took place at the After Dark bookstore when Hill stopped the officers and requested their names. The officers were in the bookstore with the knowledge and consent of the management to allege a search for a male suspected of robbing bookstores.

Mr. Hill stated that he "objected to the demeaning and abusive manner in which the officers interviewed patrons of the After Dark. After spending the night as a guest of the City on the floor of the drunk tank at 61 Riesner St., Hill was released when the District Attorney's office were unable to charge him with an offense.

# Coors beer **BOYCOTT** UPDATE

The Adolph Coors Company has announced that it will now broaden its beer operation into two additional states - **Washington** and **Missouri**. By mid-1978, 25 new distributors (owned by Coors) will begin operating in those states, bringing to 16 the number of states selling **COORS**. The fourth largest brewery in the country recently became the fifth largest as sales dropped in **California**. (Also in *Texas*.) The striking **Brewery Workers Union** here, in **Golden**, claims that the boycott of Coors has necessitated the expansion in other states.

**Joe Coors**, recently elevated to the presidency of the Coors empire, is well aware of one significant aspect of the boycott - the Gay bar boycott of Coors. In order to combat this trend, Joe purchased full-page advertisements in some Gay newspapers to claim that, "we" do not get involved in "controversial" issues such as the equal rights of Gays and women.

**Joe Coors** did not explain the lie detector test given to all prospective employees, which inquires about their personal lives. Nor did he comment on his founding of **Washington, D.C.**, groups that lobby and support candidates and issues that are anti-women and anti-Gay.

**Joe Coors** does not tell the Gay community that he was a major supporter of **Ronald Reagan** for President. It is **Reagan** who said that homosexuals "need psychiatric care." Coors also poured money into **Reagan's** effort in **Florida** during the primary. The **Reagan** effort in **Florida** was headed by **Mike Thompson**, a notorious anti-homosexual who later became the director of **Save Our Children, Inc.**

Coors has reluctantly admitted that he has supported the **John Birch Society** with many thousands of dollars. The **Birch AMERICAN OPINION** magazine as run advertisements for the **Coors Porcelain Company**, part of the **Coors** operation in **Golden**.

**Joe Coors** must be aware that the **Birch Society** has repeatedly praised Police Chief **Ed Davis** of **Los Angeles** for his anti-Gay stand. **Davis** has spoken at **Birch** functions on homosexuality. **Coors** might have read in his copy of **OPINION** that **Metropolitan Community Church** is the "pervert" church.

Through his **Washington, D.C.**, contacts, **Joe Coors** must be aware that the **Birch's** number one spokesperson in the capital is Rep. **Lawrence McDonald** (D - **Georgia**) who recently introduced an amendment to the **Legal Assistance Bill** which would bar poor Gays from receiving free legal aid.

No one can recall **Joe Coors** protesting when the day, 1977, **Birch Magazine** ran a major article, "There No Such Thing As A Good Fairy." The article says the real issue is "whether homosexuals have the right to commit perversion." It had a full-page photo of a **Austrian** youth's head being placed in a wheelbarrow. The caption reads, "So much for alleged pervert rights."

**Joe Coors** is protected at the factory by public relations men who do not discuss politics. They say that the politics of **Joe Coors** is a private matter. They also do not discuss the **Coors Employees Political Action Group** that collects money to support ultra-conservative politicians, nor do they discuss **Joe Coors'** personal habit of collecting large sums from employees to support

candidates that oppose social legislation and minority rights in the nation's capital.

In a conversation that I had with **Holly Coors**, **Joe's** wife, I clearly identified myself as a reporter for a Gay newspaper; so if she claims a confidence has been broken, I do not feel that such a claim is justified. At one point she asked me if I was "going to print all of this" and I replied that I was not taping anything. However, I was taking extensive notes.

Early in the interview, **Holly** said that "Gay militants" had threatened the **Coors** family and so she had to be careful what she said. She said that she "believed" that **Joe** shared her views.

**Holly Coors** is one of the most charming, naive, and misguided persons with whom I have ever talked. Closeted away in her **Golden, Colorado**, estate, she holds firm to her conviction that there should be "hope" for the homosexual who wishes to give up that "sinful" life. She supports **Kings Ministry**, a "born again" group of allegedly "former" homosexuals who wish to help Gay people who want to try to become heterosexual.

**Joe Coors'** wife spoke warmly of homosexuals who, she says, should have a "good alternative if they want out. If they want out, the church should help them, as they should help alcoholics or any other sinners." She adds, "Of course, we are all sinners."

Why did she think the **Coors Company** had a lie detector test that some homosexuals felt screened them out as potential employees? . . . "Well, they want to get the best people. Homosexuals are not any less moral than anyone else. Maybe they are trying to find out if a person has a criminal record."

Organized homosexuals seemed to bother **Holly Coors**. She said that homosexuals should not demand their rights as a special group, that this was "asking for special treatment." "However," she added, "they should have equal civil rights too."

Holly commented on the subject of homosexuality becoming so well publicized. She said that she even used the word, *Gay*, because "everyone does." She felt that the publicity given to homosexuality had made it a "fad" for some people. Joe's wife said that Gay people should not be "locked into it."

In a moment of real concern, Holly Coors said that the parents of a Gay woman had come to her for advice. Their daughter had gone to live with other women. Holly thought that this was unfortunate. She said that some Gay groups tell such people "that there is no hope" if you are Gay. She concluded, "There should be help for those who need help."

The Golden woman said, "We are Christians - Episcopalians" and was surprised when told that her church had taken a liberal stand on homosexuality. She later said that she knew that there were some Gay Episcopal priests. "I know some," she said laughingly.

The somewhat disorganized conversation ended with talk about Christianity. I asked if a person could be a good Christian and a practicing homosexual and she replied that it was possible. It was "a personal matter between the person and the Lord. The Lord wants us all, you know. Some just don't know where to go for help."

The interview concluded when Holly Coors asked if I were a Christian. I said, "No, agnostic." She laughed and said, "Well, you are honest. I want to say that I love the Lord Jesus Christ. That is what it is all about. I hope you find your way to accept Him."
