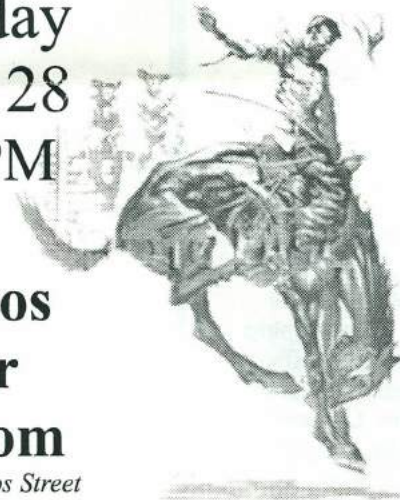



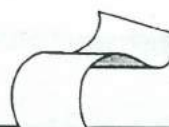

Intimacy is a bonding between two people based on trust, respect, love and the ability to share deeply. We can have intimate relationships with lovers, partners, friends and family members. Through these relationships, we experience the give and take of caring.

If handling things alone and taking care of yourself was what you had to do as a child, it may feel unfamiliar and scary to be in a close committed relationship. Some people feel claustrophobic when someone gets close.

On the other hand, some people cling to those they love becoming codependent and enmeshed, unable to tolerate a healthy level of independence.

8. **Do we both take responsibility for the relationship's successes and problems?**
9. **Is there room for me to grow and change in this relationship?**
10. **Am I able to reach my own goals within this relationship?**
11. **Is this person supportive of the kind or changes I am trying to make?**
12. **Is this person willing to help me?**

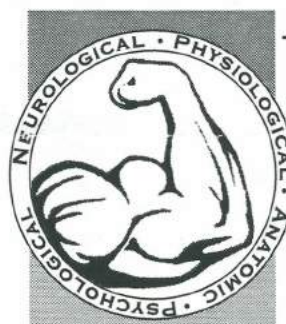

EPAH's night at Theater LAB on February 23 (call quick, it may be sold out soon 713-868-7516).

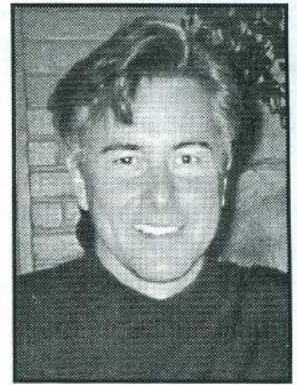
EPAH Rodeo Party February 28 at the BRB from 4-8 PM.

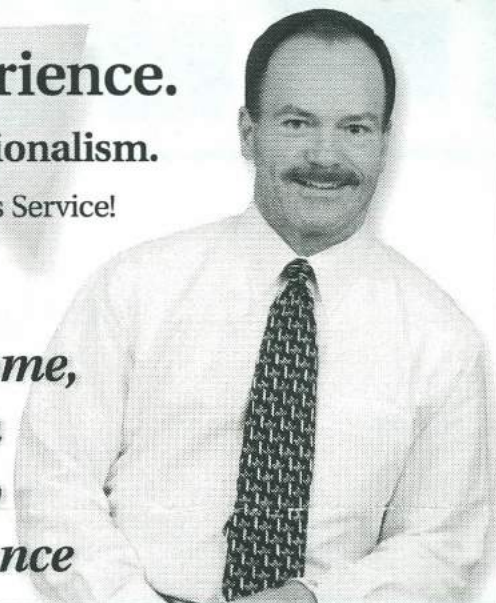
