# Season's best bet? **Bette!**

During Wednesday night's premiere of *Bette* Midler's eponymously titled sitcom, a favorite moment comes when the diva's 13-year-old daughter, Rose (Marina Malota), brings home a boyfriend. When the boyfriend meets the famous star, he gushes that he's Bette's biggest fan.

A worried Bette pulls her daughter aside and breaks the news: "He's gay."

Yes, we've always been the Divine Miss M's biggest stars. That's why we hope Hollywood pundits are correct when they label the new CBS vehicle as most likely to succeed.

And how could this autobiographical jewel not succeed, with one of the most interesting and engaging of all celebrities as its subject? That was creator and executive producer Jeffrey Lane's starting point. He knew he wanted a starring vehicle for Midler — he just couldn't settle on a character for our Bette. When finally he settled on, well, Bette, a new



star entered the CBS heaven. For storylines, he and his writers have mined Midler's extensive, rich and, shall we say, bawdy career — from her days, at age 25, when she became the toast of the Continental Baths in New York, to chart-topping success as a recording artist, to fame on film. She's also made plenty of high-powered friends along the way — including Dolly Parton and

Danny DeVito, who will make guest appearances during *Bette*'s first season.

Even her 13-year-old daughter is autobiographical, since Midler's real daughter, Sophie, is also 13. But Midler the mom apparently is quite a different creature than the stage chanteuse who belted out dirty Sophie Tucker jokes with wild abandon. Midler carefully screens Sophie's TV viewing, and she was asked recently whether Sophie is ever curious about Bette's old bathhouse days. "Not in the slightest," Midler retorted. "Let her find her own dirty jokes."

As far as guilty pleasures go, *Dynasty* creator Aaron Spelling's new *Titans* at least gives us a glimmer of hope that backstabbing, intrigue-laden rich folks haven't disappeared from the small screen forever. Victoria Principal stars, only she takes a turn from the nice girl she played

Texas native David Steakley, artistic director of Austin's Zachary Scott Theatre Center, took over the post three years ago after affiliating with the company as managing director in 1991. Under his creative supervision, the company has spread its artistic wings, becoming more daring in both subject matter and treatment. About 160,000 people annually attend performances at the "Zach," and the audience is growing more diverse.

Your production of *Angels in America* two years ago was widely seen as taking the theater to a new level.

Yes. The great thing about it is that we did both halves, and it played at Zach over the course of nine months. It was the largest audience we've had for any play in our history. The cast was also fund-raising for AIDS Services of Austin. So it was a very high profile time not only for the theater but for awareness in the Austin community. And it was great that it had such success.

You're currently running an adaptation of *Evita* conceived as a three-ring circus. What's that about?

Michael Raiford, who designed our sets, about eight months ago left a message saying, "What if Fellini had directed *Evita*?" We were really curious about that idea, so we began to immerse ourselves in Fellini movies. There were a lot of circuses in his films, either where the plot is connected to the circus or it's a metaphor for whatever he's exploring. So in our production, Perón is the lion tamer and Eva is at various times a lioness, a high-wire trapeze artist and a bull-

fight. And Che serves as the ringmaster . . . which is quite different than the normal depiction of Che.

On your smaller stage, Jaston Williams is a hit in *Tru*, the play about Truman Capote.

It's unabashedly gay in its sentiments and approach, and it's really a poignant portrait of Truman Capote. Having Jaston Williams (*Greater Tuna*) here, who is such a Texas star, not only takes the theater to a new level, the broadness of the audience is also at a new level. He's packed every performance.

You recently attended your 20th high school reunion in Grandview. As an openly-gay man, what was it like going back to your hometown and seeing your old classmates? I didn't find that people were necessarily interested in delving into personal lives. And I think people as a society and a culture have moved far enough along that that's not a factor.

As a theater professional, do you recognize any particular gay aesthetic?

People are finally accepting that the arts are essentially gay-driven in terms of the people creating, producing, acting and designing. It's important to me that all stories get told, and it's important for gay men and gay women to see relationships and friendships that are similar to the ones in their own lives. And we're at a place where that's happening.

What's your relationship status?

I'm single and dating. (Laughs)

on Dallas. (She describes the new show as "The Brady Bunch on acid.")

And heavenly Casper Van Dien — who looked so ravishing when he was bound spread-eagle, stripped to the waist and given 10 strokes of the lash in *Starship Troopers* — can apparently be expected to run around half-naked much of the time. But those of you who reveled in the glory days of *Dynasty*, when every city had a gay bar that hosted watching parties, shouldn't get your hopes up too high. Remember *Central Park West*? Didn't think so.

Hollywood wunderkid Greg Berlanti, the 28-year-old writer of *Dawson's Creek* who wrote and directed *The Broken Hearts Club*, says the show's straight stars, including doe-eyed Dean Cain, had to be tutored on the finer points of homosexuality. But Cain apparently was a star pupil.

"In a sense, it was gay school," Cain, who shares a deep onscreen kiss with Andrew Keegan, told *US Weekly*. "On the set you might hear, 'Is this too gay or not gay enough?'"

But the openly-gay Berlanti says



Cain passed gay school with flying colors. "I think the student surpassed the teacher," he joked. "He could go on to grad school, but he's chosen another university."

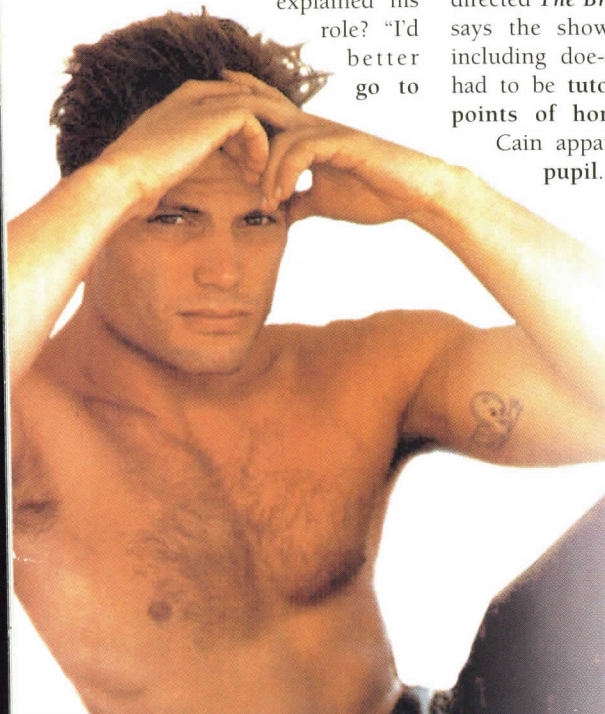

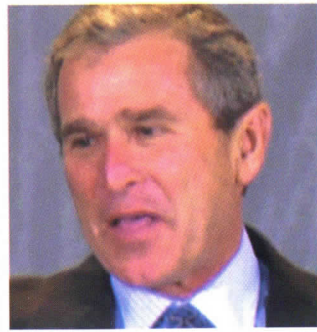

## top ten gay films

*Entertainment Weekly's* brilliant annual gay entertainment issue hit the stands last week, with in-depth coverage about Hollywood's gay power surge. The magazine interviews four openly-gay directors about their gay and not-so-gay experiences in Hollywood, poses questions about the future of gay entertainment and provides previews of upcoming gay-themed movies, television shows, CDs and plays. There's a big, fascinating feature on television's current darling, *Will & Grace*, the powerhouse of NBC's returning fall lineup, and profiles of the gay movers and shakers in the entertainment industry. **4. *Bound*.** 1996. A sexy ex-con and a gangster's girlfriend take on the mob and live happily ever after. Stars: Jennifer Tilly, Gina Gershon, Joe Pantoliano. Directors: Andy and Larry Wachowski.

**5. *The Crying Game*.** 1992. A disillusioned IRA terrorist flees London to find the girlfriend of his former prisoner — and he and the audience get a surprise. Stars: Stephen Rea, Jaye Davidson, Forest Whitaker. Director: Neil Jordan.

**6. *Gods and Monsters*.** 1998. A fictionalized but moving account of the last days of openly gay director James Whale (*Frankenstein*, *Bride of Frankenstein*). Stars: Ian McKellen, Brendan Fraser, Lynn Redgrave. Director: Bill Condon.

**7. *The Opposite of Sex*.** 1998. A hateful teen wreaks havoc on the gay relationship of her half-brother, a widower, and the sister of the widower's late mate. Stars: Christina Ricci, Lisa Kudrow, Martin Donovan. Director: Don Roos.

**8. *High Art*.** 1998. A young woman falls in love with her drug-addicted upstairs neighbor, an older photographer. Stars: Ally Sheedy, Radha Mitchell, Patricia Clarkson. Director: Lisa Cholodenko.

**9. *Priest*.** 1994. A young priest struggles to reconcile his same-sex desires with his love of God. Stars: Linus Roache, Tom Wilkinson, Robert Carlyle. Director: Antonia Byrd.

**10. *Go Fish*.** 1994. Black-and-white film features Max, a "carefree single lesbo looking for love." Stars: Guinevere Turner, T. Wendy McMillan, Anastasia Sharp. Director: Rose Troche.

## Grey Party

The 28 hosts pay all expenses related to putting on the party, so that 100 percent of the requested \$20 donation at the door goes to the beneficiaries, Beal explains.

In addition to the requested \$20 donation, attendees are required to fill out a release form. Forms are available in advance at Basic Brothers and Leather by Boots. Forms also will be available at the door. But Beal advises getting the forms in advance to avoid entry delays at the party venue.

During Grey Party weekend, Pacific Street presents on a "Shades of Grey" kickoff party on Friday night. And on Sunday, Sonoma presents a Recovery Party and T-dance, 3-8 p.m.

If it's celebrity you're after, then there are only three words you need to know: *Vanity Fair's Hollywood*.

The definitive book on a century of Hollywood glamour, power, myth and mystery, the material between the covers of *Vanity Fair's Hollywood* is drawn from the pages of *Vanity Fair* itself, from 1914 to today.

On the film front, no other magazine has achieved quite the stature of *Vanity Fair*, which through the decades has featured the work of internationally-acclaimed photographers, from Edward Steichen and Cecil Beaton to Annie Leibovitz and Herb Ritts.

Contemporary stars are well-documented, including a to-die-for photo of a gaudy Joan Collins, seated and sultry in a limo wearing a low-cut black gown with pearls at her neck and white rose at her cleavage. Other photos bear fond remembrances of Hollywood's glamorous past: Doris Day in a see-through skirt, posing with six brightly-dyed poodles. An imperious Sophia Loren giving a glimpse to Jayne Mansfield's plunging neckline. Claudette Colbert as Cleopatra. Elizabeth Taylor as Cleopatra. Lillian and Dorothy Gish sharing a



spread with Blythe Danner and Gwyneth Paltrow.

The photo captions, by Christopher Hitchens, are delicious and seductive, aptly summing up a whole career in a paragraph.

And there's plenty of sparkling conversation. Among the book's brilliant essayists are Clare Booth Luce on Garbo, P.G. Wodehouse on movie villains, D.H. Lawrence on sex appeal.

No less imperious a critic than Gore Vidal, often himself a subject of *VF's* pages, describes the new book, published in November, as “a pair of splendid Art Deco bookends . . . now brought together in a single volume . . . a kaleidoscope of startling images and urgent voices.”

The book, a dazzling display of all the brightest stars in

the Hollywood firmament, is the product of a creative team that have played a large part in *VF's* recent acclamation as best million-plus circulation magazine of the year: Graydon Carter, *VF's* editor, David Friend, *VF's* editor of creative development and former director of photography for *Life* magazine, and Hitchens, an author and *VF* contributing editor.

If this sweeping, immensely handsome book is not already on your coffee table, you should put it there post-haste. And if there's any last-minute gift-buying to do for a good gay friend, there's hardly a better choice out there.

# Night and day

Actors portraying *Queer As Folk's* most alluring twosome show interesting similarities, differences

The two characters responsible for delivering much of the sexual energy to Showtime's *Queer As Folk* — 29-year-old advertising executive Brian Kinney and 17-year-old high school student Justin Taylor — are played by actors who, like their characters, offer an interesting study in similarities and contrasts.

Although both are Georgia boys, they each took vastly different routes to Hollywood. Both were virtual unknowns before being cast in *QAF*. They are hardly unknowns anymore, after participating in the first episode's alluring and erotic sex scene that set the tone for the series.

As Showtime's explicit and seductive series got underway, both men — Gale Harold (Brian) and Randy Harrison (Justin) — took time out to speak to their hometown newspaper, the *Atlanta Journal-Constitution*. As production for the series continued in Toronto, the pair passed a cell phone between them as they answered questions.

Like his character, the brash and open Justin, Harrison is more

revealing about his personal life. At 23, he's one of two openly-gay actors on the show (the other is Peter Paige, who plays the queenly Emmitt). On the other hand, Harold won't speak about his sexuality (draw your own conclusions about that).

In fact, Harold is if anything even more guarded than his character, the promiscuous 29-year-old who "doesn't do boyfriends." Although Harold attended Southwest DeKalb High School in the Atlanta suburb, he won't reveal his age or when he graduated. Like his character, Harrison attended a private school, Pace Academy in the Atlanta suburb of Buckhead.

Harrison got involved in the project just as he'd completed studies at theater school at the University of Cincinnati's Conservatory of Music. He had just moved to New York when he auditioned for *Queer As Folk*.

"I had no TV or film experience," he told the newspaper. "I got the script for the first three episodes and read them on the plane when I had to fly out to L.A."

Harold, on the other hand, was already living in the U.S. film capital, slogging relentlessly from audition to audition. He was working for a small theater company and had been cast in a small, independent film when he tried out for the Showtime series.

"I was totally unknown to everyone," he said during the interview. "It's a dream situation. One day I'm running out of gas trying to make auditions. The next I'm in a new city [Toronto], acting, trying to maintain the moment in the most extreme situations."

He's talking, of course, about the infamous sex scene with Harrison, which took place on the second day of shooting.

"We had no choice," Harrison said. "It was all or nothing. So we just went for it. It was great. It broke down all the walls."

Harold told the newspaper the scene was "unforgettable."

"It's unfathomable how important that experience was. I was pushed to the limit," he said. "We both read the script, knew what it was about and decided to do it. Once we committed, there was no
