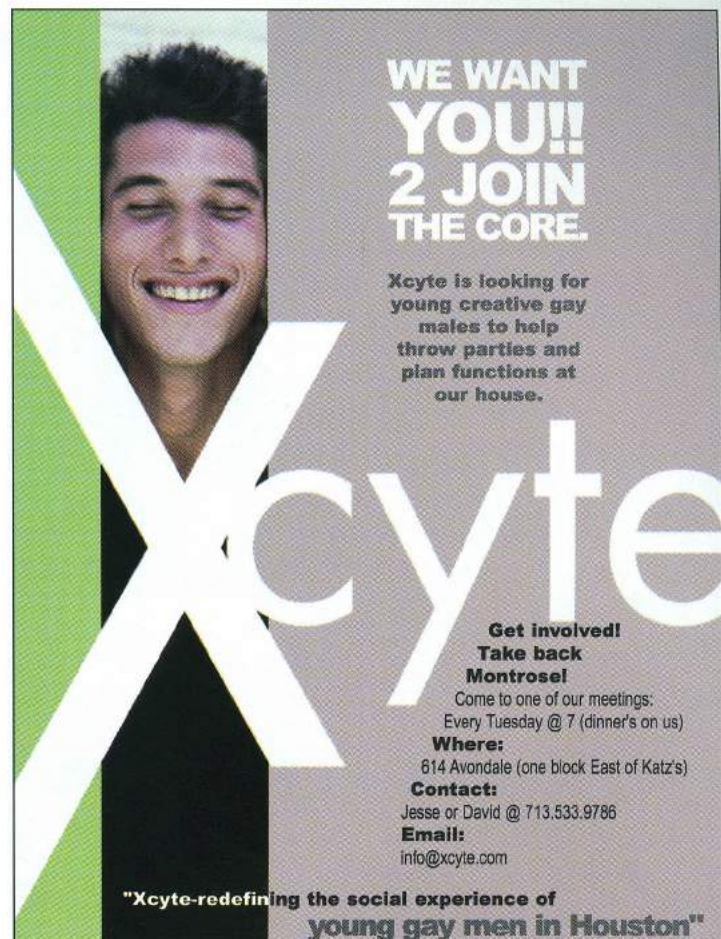

singer and former soap star's life, at Melbourne, Australia's annual Gay and Lesbian Cultural Festival last January. And after months of speculation and doubt, it seems the show is going to be taken to a wider audience — after getting the thumbs-up from the singer herself.

Kylie's tour promoter Michael Gudinsky promises, "This has been something we have been looking at for quite a while, but it's a slow boat to China.

"It has the working title of *I Should Be So Lucky*, and we're currently looking at scripts."

The musical — a romantic comedy — is expected to feature around 20 Kylie songs and will be similar to the current Queen musical, *We Will Rock You*.

Reggae star Beenie Man has dismissed suggestions he's a homophobe after British gay groups called for a boycott of his new single with Janet Jackson.

The Jamaican dance hall king says he's never had a problem with gays and believes UK-based human rights group Outrage! must have misunderstood his lyrics.

He says, "My single has nothing to do with gay people. I have nothing to say against gay people. The more guys that are gay means more girls for me. I don't know why they're against my single."

The singer, whose "Feel It Boy" collaboration with Jackson is set to climb the pop charts, says he thinks the misunderstanding may result from people mishearing lyrics on some of his

older songs which refer to "chi-chi men."

He says, "They come and say we say chi-chi man, and we cuss gays as chi-chi men. Chi-chi man is the name of a person, it's the Prime Minister.

"We wanna cuss the Jamaican Prime Minister but we cannot say the Prime Minister's name on record 'cos you be going to jail. You call him a chi-chi man."

However, a spokesman for Outrage! insists, "Beenie Man makes Eminem sound like a Girl Scout cupcake salesman.

"The more exposure these people are given, the more mainstream they and their views become."

Music label Jive Records may have to turn to animation for Steps' secret last single promo — because the band mates refuse to be in the same room with each other.

The group split last December and have publicly separated into two groups of pals — Lisa Scott-Lee, Faye Tozer and Lee Latchford Evans on one side, and Ian 'H' Watkins and Claire Richards, who have begun a new pop career as a duo, on the other.

Before they went their separate ways, the "Tragedy" hit makers recorded "Baby Don't Dance," which Jive is planning to release next month.

However, with the two camps slamming each other in the tabloids, the chances of them reuniting to record a video is looking increasingly slim.

## 2nd Annual Lone Star Ride Fighting AIDS

**WHEN:** September 28-29

**WHERE:** Approximately 175-mile route beginning in Fort Worth, with an overnight stay in Lake Ray Roberts State Park (east of Sanger, TX); ending in Dallas.

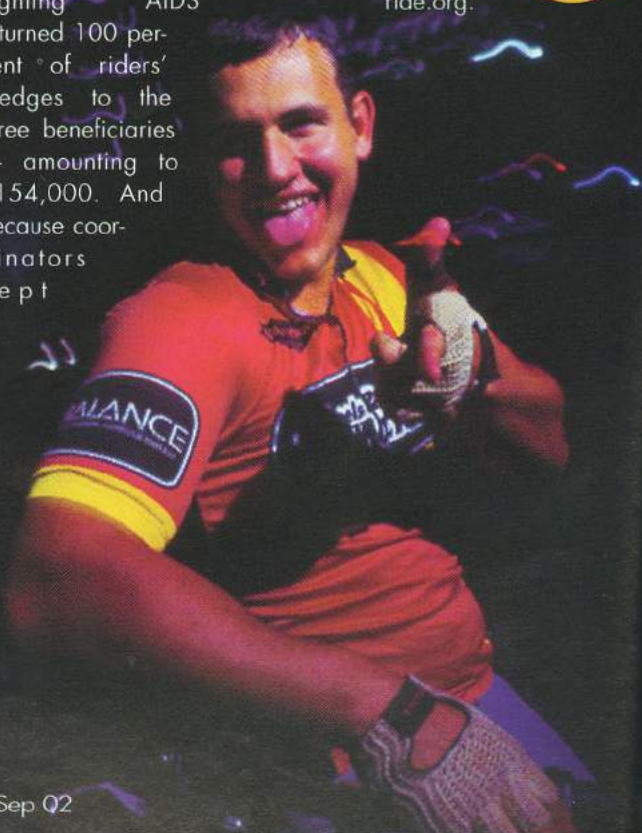
**COST:** Each rider pays a \$75 registration fee and must raise \$1,000 in pledges to participate. Each crew member pays a \$50 registration fee. Fees include tent accommodations and facilities at Lake Ray Roberts State Park, meals and full road support. Participants must be at least 17 years old.

**THE LOWDOWN:** Unlike the low returns from some high profile AIDS rides around the country, last year's inaugural Lone Star Ride Fighting AIDS returned 100 percent of riders' pledges to the three beneficiaries — amounting to \$154,000. And because coordinators kept

costs low and relied on donations of money, goods and services from area foundations and businesses, an additional amount in corporate donations also was contributed to the beneficiaries.
