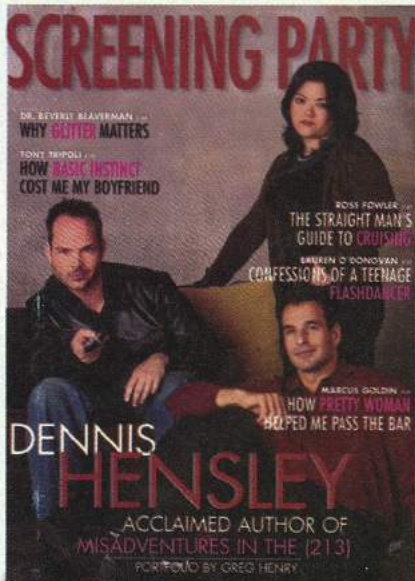

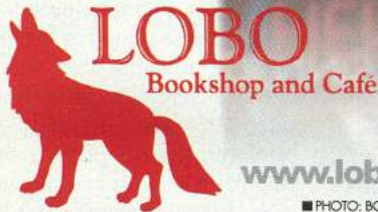

13. Carry on items should be limited to the following: Magazines,

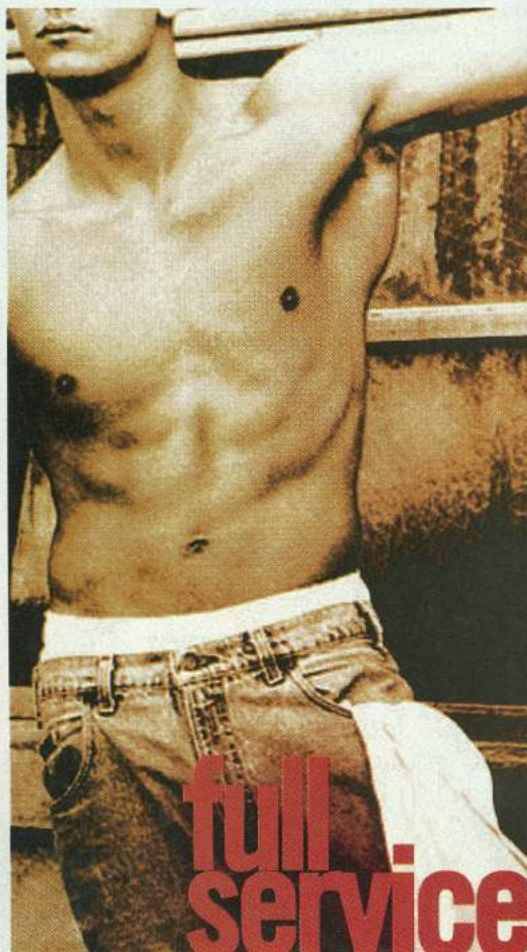


CD players, Designer Luggage (ONLY), gum, breath mints.

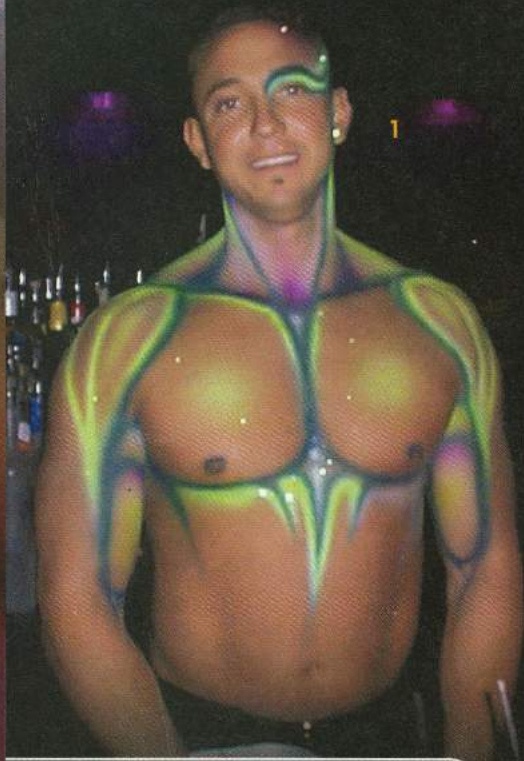
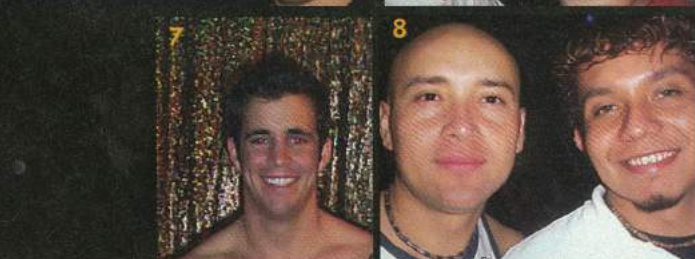

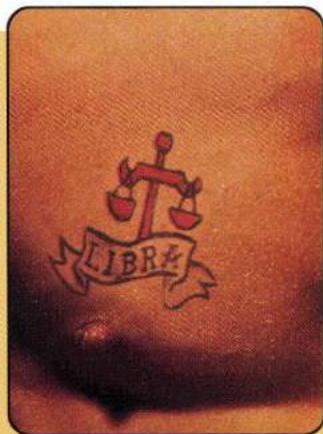
