

Funds Needed For WWII Project

"Socially dangerous homosexuals should be ... placed in a suitable detention camp for the duration of the war."

— Surgeon General, U. S. Navy, 1942

Have you ever read a history book that told you about America's secret plans to set up detention camps for homosexuals during World War II? Or how any of the more than 1 million lesbian and gay World War II veterans served their country 40 years ago?

No. Because historians have written gay people out of American history.

Allan Berube, of San Francisco, has spent the last three years interviewing the gay veterans of World War II. He has listened to the stories they have never told anyone before. Stories, he says "that made me angry, sad and proud."

His book-in-progress is about these stories, and about an unjust military policy that began while these veterans were still young. A policy that has ruined the lives of nearly 100,000 men and women and grows more intolerable each year.

Since 1981, the *World War II Project* has collected the stories, letters and photographs of lesbians and gay men who served in World War II. It has uncovered secret memos that expose the roots of the military's anti-gay policies. And it has created new ways to educate the public about this hidden part of American History.

For the first time, these most unknown of the unknown soldiers are telling their stories in their own words.

Berube says: "I wish you could have been with me when I listened to a woman who was kicked out of the WACs during a 1950s witch hunt. She told me with so much pride how she and her friends fought back by starting San Francisco's first lesbian newsletter, which they called the 'Eclipse.'"

"Or when a Jewish man laughed while he told me about his Army drag show in Oklahoma, then quietly and carefully told me that it was *his* company that had liberated Dachau.

"Or when a Navy veteran tried to convey the fear and loneliness he felt when he had to stay behind on his ship while he watched his boyfriend leave for the beachhead at Iwo Jima.

"Or when another navy veteran still remembered the nicknames he gave the other sailors locked up in a "queer stockade" in the South Pacific, nicknames to keep their spirits

up during a terrifying anti-gay witch hunt."

Berube's work has already gotten some publicity:

- "Marching to a Different Drummer," a 90-minute documentary slide presentation about lesbian and gay Americans during World War II, has been shown over 100 times in more than 20 cities.

- "Gays at War," a 1983 cover story in *Mother Jones* magazine, introduced the story of lesbian and gay World War II veterans to a wide audience for the first time. Nearly 2 years later, people still pass on worn copies to friends, relatives and legislators to help them understand the roots of gay pride.

- *Coming Out Under Fire*, a book-in-progress, is the first comprehensive history of gay Americans in World War II. From Orlando, Florida to Seattle, Washington, TV and radio, magazines and newspapers have followed the book's progress in interviews and feature stories.

The World War II Project was originally sponsored by the San Francisco Lesbian and Gay History Project. In 1982-3, people from all over the U. S. and Canada made pledges to the Project's first research grant. That grant enabled Berube to interview over 50 veterans, spend a month buried deep in the stacks of the National Archives, take the slide show all over the country, and begin writing *Coming Out Under Fire*.

But since the grant ran out this year,

important work has been left undone. The slide show sits in boxes. Letters pile up unanswered. Opportunities to interview veterans are lost. And each day, new appeals come in from student groups, veterans, service-people, attorneys, and journalists. They want more history to help them fight the military's escalating war against gay men and women.

Aware of these growing demands, the San Francisco Lesbian and Gay History Project has decided to take the first steps toward establishing the World War II Project as an independent resource center with a full-time, two-person staff. This will ensure that the Project can: 1) continue its pioneering historical research, 2) preserve valuable documents, and 3) produce the educational materials that are needed more and more each day. To do this, they need to raise \$40,000 through pledges, grants and benefits.

Since there are still few foundations that will fund lesbian and gay history, the organization is largely dependent on the donations of individuals. Contributors will receive a quarterly newsletter in exchange for their tax-deductible donation. Here are a few examples of what this money will be used for:

- **Oral History Interviews.** In December 1983, at Christmas, Woodie Wilson traveled across the country just before he died to talk with Berube for an article especially commissioned by *The Front Page*. He talked about the gay GI newsletter he started in

South Carolina in 1943. There are more than 80 other people willing and eager to tell their stories; a \$10 pledge will sponsor a 3-hour oral history interview.

- **Archives.** The Project wants a permanent archive to preserve the history of lesbian and gay veterans. But, even now, this already means maintaining over 200 hours of oral history tapes and thousands of letters, photos, clippings, scrapbooks and government documents.

- **Freedom of Information Act Requests.** The Project already has nearly 3,000 pages of memos that expose the military's secret anti-gay plans during World War II. But the Freedom of Information Act is in jeopardy under the current administration. Donations will be used to declassify the remaining documents already known about while there's still time; a \$25 pledge will declassify 100 pages of secret military documents.

- **Education.** Most important of all, your pledge will take this story to millions of people with slide shows, fact sheets, court testimony, articles and the pioneering book *Coming Out Under Fire*.

The World War II detention camp proposals, "queer stockades" and witch hunts were not the end of an era, but a shameful beginning. Under the current administration, the military's anti-gay policies are alive and well. In fact, they have become the most severe in our nation's history, with discharges doubling in the last decade to nearly 2,000 each year!

Last year the Pentagon spent over \$23 million to kick out nearly 2,000 lesbians and gay men. "Your pledge can stop this senseless persecution," Berube says. "No matter how you feel about the military, the story of how a whole generation of gay people survived the military's war against them must never be forgotten."

In pleading for funds, Berube adds "Now more than ever, it is urgent that the World War II Project find new ways to continue the work we've only just begun." 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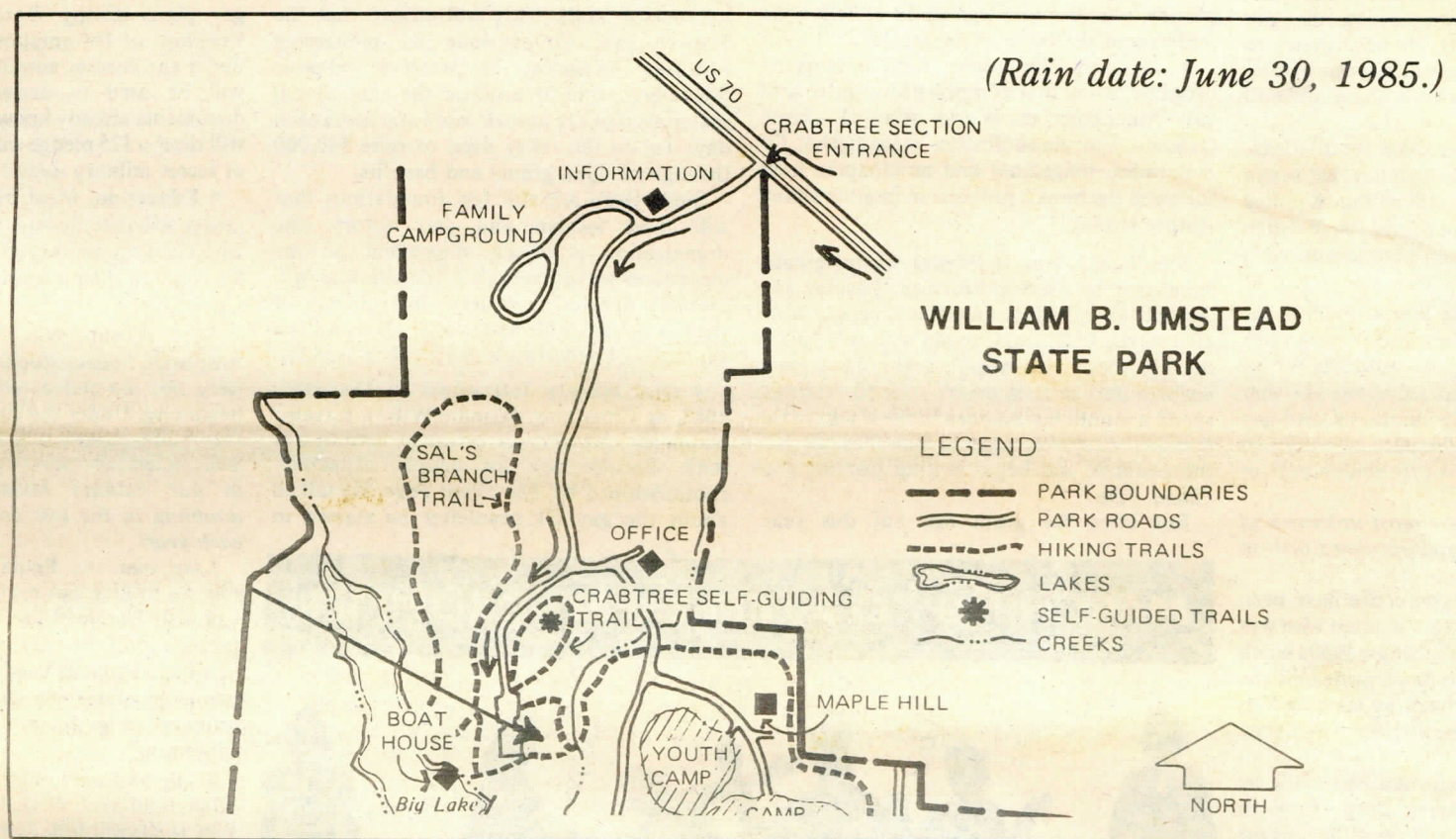

Anti-Gay Bills Introduced in N.C.

Two anti-gay bills were introduced by fundamentalist Republicans led by Rep. Michael Decker (R-Forsyth) in the last two days for introducing bills into the North Carolina General Assembly this session.

House Bill 1186, introduced May 17, would prohibit University of North Carolina campuses from giving official recognition or aid to any "club or organization that is made up of avowed homosexuals or that advocates homosexuality."

"I've been told there are homosexual clubs operating on campus," Decker said (*Durham Morning Herald*, 5/18/85), "and promoting homosexuality by recruiting members." The bill would not apply to "legitimate" groups that discover they have practicing homosexuals among their members, Decker added.

Local school boards would be allowed to dismiss teachers for "advocating" or engaging in "public homosexual activity" under legislation introduced May 16, House Bill 1173.

Under the bill, school officials would consider whether the teacher's past or present homosexuality (or the knowledge of it) would hurt children, when and where the acts occurred and whether the teacher would be likely to encourage children to follow the example in deciding if the teacher is unfit for his job.

"It's not just putting your arm around someone," Decker said (*Winston-Salem Journal*, 5/16/85). "It's conduct. I don't want to be specific."

Both bills were immediately termed "patently unconstitutional" in letters sent by North Carolina Human Rights Fund President Leo Teachout to legislators on the committees studying the bills.

In a letter to the House Judiciary IV Committee, which is studying HB 1173, Teachout noted that the bill is virtually identical to an Oklahoma law declared unconstitutional in a lawsuit brought by the National Gay Task Force.

"Press reports at the time HB 1173 was introduced indicate that its sponsors believe the Oklahoma law was upheld by the Supreme Court," Teachout wrote. "In fact, the lower court decision striking down the law was affirmed."

In a letter to the Higher Education Committee of the House, which is studying HB 1186, Teachout noted that there was no judicial authority in support of a law barring aid to gay student groups.

"Every federal circuit court of appeals that has considered the question has ruled that the First Amendment requires publicly-funded colleges and universities to extend recognition to homosexual student groups on the same basis as it is extended to other student groups," Teachout wrote. "This includes the court of appeals with jurisdiction over North Carolina."

Rep. Decker, the lead sponsor on both bills,

is a teacher at a fundamentalist Christian school near Winston-Salem. Prior to introducing these bills he was best known for his adamant opposition to state regulation of child day-care centers.

Joining Decker as co-sponsors of both bills were Reps. Coy Privette of Kannapolis, the head of the Christian Action League, and Walt Windley of Gastonia. Other co-sponsors of HB 1173 were John Brown of Elkin, Robert Brawley of Mooresville, Jim Craven of Aberdeen, and Richard Chalk and Steve Wood, both of High Point.

At the time HB 1173 was introduced Rep. Decker was quoted (*News and Observer* 5/16/85) as saying, "All we're doing is strengthening what's already in the law — that it is illegal to practice public homosexuality." Decker also said that the bill would not bar the hiring of homosexuals as teachers.

He added that saying "I'm gay" would not be grounds for dismissing a teacher because punishing "him" for what "he" said would be a violation of "his" constitutionally guaranteed freedom of speech.

However, according to NCHRF Executive Director Dan Kindsvater, the bill would do a lot more than Decker claims.

For one thing, the bill defines "public homosexual conduct" to mean "advocating, soliciting, imposing, encouraging, or promoting public or private homosexual activity in a manner that creates a substantial risk that the conduct will come to the attention of school children or school employees."

Accordingly, any teacher who attended a service of the Metropolitan Community Church could probably be dismissed. So could a teacher who wrote a letter to the newspaper advocating repeal of the "crime against nature" law.

Another strange aspect of the bill is that it defines "public homosexual activity" by referring to the definition of "sexual act" contained in the statute covering rape and other sexual assaults. However, it provides for dismissal only "if the act is performed with a person of the same sex and if it is indiscreet and not practiced in private."

In his letter to the Judiciary IV Committee, NCHRF President Teachout said that this part of the bill "creates the dangerous impression that any form of 'heterosexual' activity — even rape or sexual assault — is of less concern than even the mention of the existence of homosexuality. It is an insult to the victims of sexual assault, most of them women, to suggest that a teacher who perpetrates one of the 'sexual acts' defined in the 'Rape and Other Sex Offenses' statute, G.S. 14-27.1(4), will be subject to dismissal only if he and his victim are the same sex!"

Oklahoma's Back, Too...

The Oklahoma House of Representatives voted unanimously May 15 to approve a bill which would call for the dismissal of any teacher who advocates or promotes homosexual activity or who practices homosexual activity "in such a manner that such activity is indiscreet and not practiced in private..."

The bill was introduced only three weeks after the U.S. Supreme Court voted 4-4 on the constitutionality of a similar Oklahoma measure, the Helms Act. The Supreme Court's tie vote upheld the 10th Circuit Court's

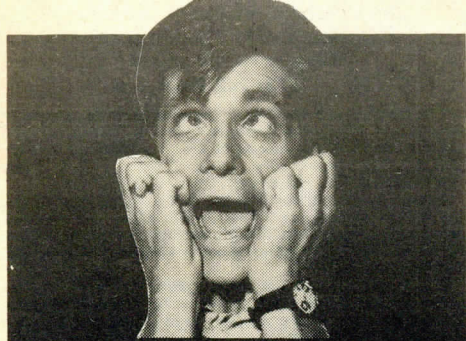
decision that the Helms Act was an unconstitutional violation of teacher's free speech rights.

This latest version, introduced by Rep. Gary Sherrer, is now pending in the State Senate's Public Education Committee.

The Oklahoma Senate already has on its calendar another anti-gay bill from the House. On March 27, the Oklahoma House voted 63 to 35 to approve a housing bill which includes a clause allowing landlords to discriminate against Gays.

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Policeman to Be Reinstated

The North Carolina Court of Appeals on May 7 upheld a lower court decision ordering the City of Asheville to reinstate a police officer who was discharged in 1981 for soliciting a male officer for sex.

A Buncombe County Superior Court jury had found in 1983 that the Chief of Police acted without justification in dismissing Patrolman Wayne E. Warren.

Warren admitted at trial that he had told his roommate, Robert Warlick, that he wanted to perform oral sex on Warlick. However, Warren said he made that statement only in an effort to determine whether Warlick was homosexual.

Warlick, who was also a police officer,

reported the incident to his superior officers. Warren was ordered to take a polygraph test, which included the questions, "Are you a homosexual?" and "Have you ever had a homosexual encounter in the Asheville area?" On his lawyer's advice, Warren refused to take the test.

The city contended that it was justified in firing Warren, because (1) soliciting another officer to commit crime against nature constitutes "conduct unbecoming to an officer" and (2) refusal to take a polygraph test constitutes "insubordination."

The court of appeals rejected both of the city's arguments, saying that there was adequate evidence to support the jury's verdict.

On the question of Warren's refusal to take the lie detector test, the court held that police officers can be dismissed for failure to take a polygraph test only if the questions relate specifically and narrowly to the performance of official duties.

"Neither of these questions related specifically and narrowly to plaintiff's official duties and the charge being investigated," the court said in a unanimous opinion by Judge Cozort. "As a matter of law, plaintiff was justified in refusing to take a polygraph examination which included those questions."

It is not known whether the City of Asheville will ask the state supreme court to hear the case. •

THE WIT AND WISOM OF QUENTIN CRISP, edited and compiled by Guy Kettlehack; Harper & Row, 141 p. quality paperback; \$8.95

FLAME, A LIFE ON THE GAME, by Flame; Gay Men's Press (London); 159p. quality paperback; \$6.50; distributed in America by Alyson Publications, P.O. Box 2783, Boston, MA 02208

In *Wit and Wisdom*, the most quotable lines by the author of *The Naked Civil Servant*, *How to Become A Virgin*, and other books are excerpted.

Crisp, whose articles and commentary have appeared in *New York*, *Esquire*, *Christopher Street*, and the *Advocate*, holds forth on a variety of topics, ranging from style to "the most erotic film every made."

Quentin Crisp, 76, became well-known only after his autobiography was made into an acclaimed television film. Since moving to the United States, Crisp has toured extensively in his one-man show, "An Evening with Quentin Crisp."

In addition to this volume (assembled by editor Kettlehack), Crisp has just published his ninth book, *Manners from Heaven*. He recently just returned from London where he was featured in the remake of *The Bride of Frankenstein* (starring Jennifer Beals and Sting). And, to top things off, he has just made his debut on a series of six new birthday greeting cards from "Male America" of New York!

Crisp recently told Norfolk's *Our Own* that he does not consider himself a writer. "I've only written seven or eighty books in fifty years." Nevertheless, *The Wit and Wisdom of Quentin Crisp* is ample evidence to the contrary. A must for Crisp-followers, and an easy introduction for neophytes.

Flame, a new book set in swinging London and the more staid but equally vibrant Midlands, is full of adventures similar to those of Quentin Crisp a half a century earlier. Sexually initiated at twelve, young Stephen is

determined not to waste his life. He decides to imitate his mother, a prostitute, and becomes Flame, effeminate "child whore" and occasional drag queen. I recommend it as a "flaming slice of gay life."

THE RAGING PEACE: Volume One of the Throne Trilogy, by Artemis Oak Grove; Lace Publications (P.O. Box 10037, Denver, CO 80210-0037), 257p. quality paperback; \$7.95 (add \$1.05 for postage and handling)

Book one of Artemis Oak Grove's proposed Throne Trilogy, *The Raging Peace*, makes no attempt at political correctness. On the contrary, the book can only be described as a lesbian one-hander or, in Pat Califia's words, "lesbian trash. This is not a book to give your mother to 'educate' her about gayness," says Califia. "It is the kind of book to read under your covers with a flashlight and (if you're lucky) your lover down between your legs."

There is plenty of explicit sex here, including sadomasochism and fisting. But unlike grindhouse variety lesbianism — produced by and for straight men — *The Raging Peace* is erotica for womyn. The book also features murder, mystery, lady lawyers, brawling dykes, vengeful priestesses and even love.

No literature this; only lively and stimulating reading.

The Gay Presses of New York — Calamus Books, J. H. Press, and the Sea Horse Press — are a major force in contemporary gay male writing. Many of the young authors they published — like Harvey Fierstein — have since become famous. J. H. Press has been a major factor in the development of gay drama, while Sea Horse and Calamus have introduced young gay poets like Dennis Cooper and Richard Ronan. And Felice Picano's anthology *A True Likeness: Lesbian and Gay Writing Today* has become a standard text in gay literature courses.

Perhaps the most popular story in *A True Likeness* was Bob Herron's "Moritz Goes to a Garden Party," in which Moritz and three

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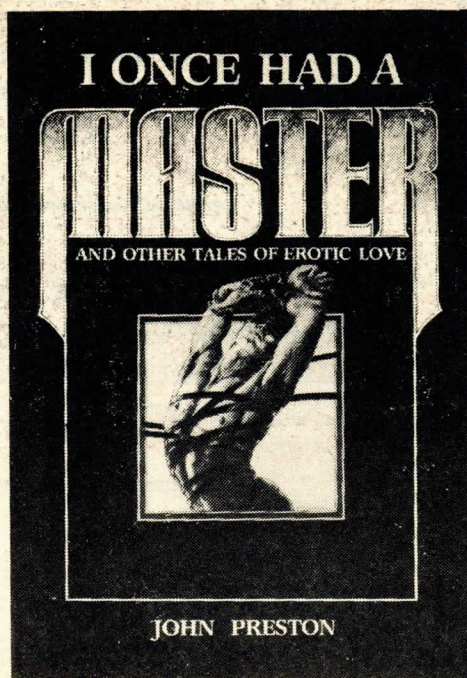

other leathermen have an orgy while their pissy next-door neighbor conducts a garden party at the same time. A freak accident brings down the walls, and the rest is madness. It's no wonder that Moritz became the most popular gay literary character this side of Mister Benson, and it was only a matter of time before he got a book of his own.

Moritz! is the story of Moritz Jellico, a poor but honest farm boy who is blessed by an eleven-inch blockbuster of an (uncut!) cock. Moritz grows tired of the sticks and moves to New York City, where he becomes as popular as Howard Schnellenberger in Miami after the Orange Bowl game. But life is no bowl of cherries for Moritz, for he gets a vibrator stuck up his ass, makes a mess of himself while performing in a Greenwich Village sleaze bar, and catches V. D. on Fire Island. But he also gets all the tricks he can handle, becomes rich and famous, and even falls in love. What we (the readers) get is a million laughs.

Moritz! is a brilliant satire on urban gay life before AIDS, and is the funniest gay book since Sheila Ortiz Taylor's *Faultline*. The book is addictive — I couldn't put it down once I started it — but it's worth the fix. *Moritz!* has made gay life gay again.

Briefly noted:

Professor Raymond Berger, whose book *Gay and Gray* was reviewed in *The Front Page* last month (Vol. 6, No. 8), writes that there are a million gay men over 65 who don't identify with the young gay community or the straight world. They are lonely but have not figured out how to meet each other.

The Male Couple authors David McWhirter and Andrew Mattison are continuing their research into long-term gay and lesbian relationships. Cleis Press has just published *Long Way Home: The Odyssey of a Lesbian Mother and Her Children* by Jeanne Jullian. It is an intimate account of a custody case that mobilized the emerging forces of the lesbian, feminist and gay movements.

Jeanne Jullian, a lesbian mother living in Oakland, California, lost custody of her children (Jesse, 4, and Paul, 8) in Alameda Superior Court on May 23, 1977. After a 3-day hearing in which her husband presented no case, called no witnesses, and did not question her parenting ability or personal character, Judge Gordon Minder granted custody of both boys to the father.

Jullian wrote this book as both historical document and personal memoir, the story of a woman who wanted to provide a loving home for her children, but had to make headlines to do it. She intends her book to be a source of strength and inspiration to all lesbians and gay

men whose lives are made richer by their children. In fact, she considers the book to be an organizing resource for all who may face custody battles in the future. Political and legal strategies are reportedly so well-documented here that one might view the book as a text in defence of the right to parent. In addition, the author has included a brief bibliography and list of resources on the subject.

Two new publications are beginning in North Carolina. One in Charlotte, called *The Lambda Connection*, began in April. The other, called *Glitter*, is based in Wilmington and will make its debut on June 14.

Q-Notes, the newsletter published by the Queen City Quordinators in Charlotte, folded in November 1984. According to one QCQ member, the organization considered itself "out of the newsletter business." Picking up the responsibilities, however, is a group which publishes *The Lambda Connection*. "It has been received with great response," according to Sammy Jackson, QCQ Co-Quordinator.

Glitter, which covers "gay entertainment news" in the area, is being published by Pageant Associates. Scheduled to appear every six weeks, the newsletter will be available by subscription and in show lounges and bars.

The first edition of *Glitter* will feature a cover story on North Carolina's first Miss Gay Azalea, a continuing feature on "Comedy Queens You Should Know," a "For Men Only" column, and information on pageant activities in North Carolina, South Carolina and Virginia.
