is queer . . . or is trying to be. United States, with its homosexual capitals like New York City, Los Angeles, San Francisco, New Orleans and Miami, Florida, are not the only places that are jumping with homosexuals of both sexes. The little towns all over the country are jumping out-of-their-jeans with faggots—active and passive.

I'm from a little hayseed-town in the middle west and that's where I was *turned on* . . . by a respected lawyer of the community . . . also, he happened to be the *father* of the girl I thought I would somedary marry. He taught me the practice of homosexuality when I was barely in my teens. I became his *lover* and remained his *boy* through all the years he put me through college. The only thing that didn't work out the way he planned it for me was that I never went back to him, my hometown . . . or his daughter after graduation. I had a new lover of *my own* by then and I traveled the world and learned that I wasn't the only queer guy in the world. I was one of *too many* to even think of myself as *different* from anyone else anymore. It seemed that most of the people I met in the slicker and more sophisticated circles were all *THAT WAY*, or, were either *condoning* it, if not practicing it.

I suppose there was a time when I could have turned back from the road of homosexuality . . . but I didn't. My experience in sex relations with men had been pleasant . . . and profitable. I soon became so adjusted to it that I never thought of women in any way, other than to be courteous and to treat them with respect. I like women—as people—but I could no more have a romantic, or physical affair with them—than the normal man could consider himself going to bed with another man. Faggots aren't born—at least I don't know any who were—I would guess that 99 per cent of homosexuals are conditioned to it by *preference*—and circumstances.

I have had many people *want to ask* me 'How I became a homosexual,' and I think that in fairness to all the off-beat people who are swinging A.C. or D.C. that I should answer that question to the best of my knowledge and ability. I will hold no bars and will tell the truth as I have lived it, and *know* it . . . because to me, I don't believe there is any wrong in the way of life I have chosen for myself.

I try to live with dignity and decorum. I am as much shocked and appalled by sex maniacs who attack children, or force themselves on the young as the next man on the street. I believe that people so sick and degenerate should be removed from society the same as any insane or diseased person should be kept from contact with society . . . but, on the other hand, I do not feel that persons who have chosen to live a life of the 'Third Sex,' who are not intruding on the lives of others who do not believe as we do should be held up to ridicule and mockery because of this choice we have made. There are many fine men and women, outstanding and upstanding citizens of worth and value to the community and to the world who are homosexual. What

one man chooses to do in his personal and private sexual life should not be of any interest to the world at large as long as he is not forcing himself, and his beliefs, on others who do not agree with him or understand his preference of sexual behaviour. The world is richer, down through the ages, for the contributions of men and women who have been our greatest philosophers, writers, teachers, musicians and painters who were homosexuals.

Homosexuality is a great problem in society today *because* it is out-in-the-open now, since the last World War, and not hidden behind closed doors as it had been all the years before. Statistics show that there isn't any *more* homosexuality taking place now than there has been all the hundreds of years of civilization . . . it's just that men, who are so inclined to be *different* in their sexual activities than the accepted heterosexual man and woman relationship, have decided to be *honest* with themselves and their neighbors by *showing* what they are, and hoping that they will be accepted for what they are, and not have to live underground like moles with a dark secret. If homosexuality is accepted publicly, and I don't mean the type of queens and faggots that pleasure themselves by transvestitism—dressing in women's clothes and wearing make-up, flaunting themselves in public, disgracing themselves—as well as their brothers and sisters who are also lavender around the edges—the *sane homosexual* would probably be the finest of the citizens if it were possible for him to attend church, join in business, community projects, along with the so-called normal men and

women . . . if he were not disqualified from the regular activities of the community in which he lives . . . maybe he wouldn't be so queer. Being a minority of any sort is damning enough . . . also it makes members of minorities *stronger* and more protective of themselves—and *that* can make them dangerous.

I believe that anyone who becomes a homosexual, and adopts it actively, has to have the leanings, desire and tendencies there to begin with . . . or he would never go all the way with it, as I have.

I know of other young men of my set, socially and in grade school, high school, and college, who played around with other boys . . . in sex experiments, just for kicks . . . who didn't *take* to it, or didn't like it . . . and forgot it. They have all married and settled down and have lovely wives and children and have never thought of their one-time deviation since it took place. On the other hand, a few boys . . . including myself . . . kept at it, enjoyed it, and made it part of our lives.

I was fortunate to have a *sponsor* to guide me through school, pay my expenses . . . and in every respect he treated me like his son . . . except that he also liked to go to bed with me. I have a true devotion to that man . . . but I also never want to see him again for what he did to his own daughter . . . and me. It wasn't until I matured that I realized what a horrible thing that man had done to two young lives. I could never go back to her. I am too honest for that. I could never see her together with her father, and I had become so indoctrinated into my sex habits with other males that I had only one choice, and that was to accept my homosexuality honestly and to live as quietly and decently as I could with it.

When I left high school and my hometown to come to New York to attend college, I thought that my homosexual activities would end by being away from my older man friend who

had taught me all I knew about homosexual activity. I was happy to leave that little town *and* also the man. Although I had an affection for him—I was ridden with a deep sense of guilt about what had taken place between us during the last years. I actually believed that once I was away from him all homosexual drives and urges would disappear. But it was too late. I tried to interest myself in girls on the campus and in classes . . . but I was drawn to the more handsome and attractive young men instead.

Kids in school never seem to have enough money to do everything they want to do. Although my immediate expenses were taken care of, I had very little beer money . . . or movie money. Economics have probably turned more boys queer than any other factor. I started hanging out in little *gay* bars in Greenwich Village where men would buy young fellow drinks, take them to good restaurants for dinner, movies and the theatre—and eventually to their apartments and to bed. It was fun . . . and the majority of the men who took me out for an evening on the town . . . were nice men

The first summer vacation from college a man I had met who liked me very much took me to Europe. I was thrilled over the trip. He was a businessman. Respectable and not at all an obvious old queen. I went with him posing as his *secretary*, which fooled no one we met abroad . . . but, also, in Europe nobody *cared* what our relationship was. When we returned to the States I moved into his apartment and lived with him for several months. It was a pleasant relationship . . . but, as most homosexual affairs go . . . it was soon over and as we had both *tired of our affair*, we parted friends and I started going out with other men.

Homosexual love affairs can be turbulent, violent and emotionally stronger and more upsetting than heterosexual love affairs. One always cares more than the other, and jealousy usually is the cause of most homosexual break-ups. I have been in love only once with a man. Really in love. And it was such a horribly disastrous, mixed-up part of my life that I will never allow myself to become emotionally entangled, or involved with anyone again. Homosexuals should live alone with their strange way of life. Homosexuals are too unsure and insecure of life to try and share it with another who is also suffering from the same insecurities that the *gay life*

The *gay life* is really the saddest life in the world . . . in the long run. A homosexual must learn to face the fact that he is always *alone*. He cannot share, or be part of another's life . . . even another homosexual . . . because they are both alone. The homosexual must learn to live for the moment . . . for if he realizes that he has no future, because of this *aloneness* that is part of homosexuality, he will not want to go on living. It is this sensitivity and awareness that homosexuals have that lead to the high percentage of suicides among their kind. But there is also the homosexual whose intelligence and love of life and beauty forces him to lead a marvelously full life that is interesting and worthwhile.

I have been asked if I ever had the desire to try and be normal . . . I must confess, that I believe there are times in every homosexual's life when they would sell their soul to be anything than what they are . . . QUEER!

There is a stigma about being known as a deviate, pansy, queer, faggot, or queen. No matter how brazen homosexuals appear to be about accepting their own plight of being so different . . . they all hate it. Even though we chose our way of life . . . we still don't like it in its entirety and the restrictions it places on us. Even though I don't approve of a lot of normal heterosexual's activities any more than I do a lot of the homosexual's philanderings. I don't know of any homosexual who has ever been successful in trying to return to normalcy.

I have been to psychiatrists and have ended up either more confused than I was before I went to take treatment . . . or with an awful *crush* on the doctor. Either way, it has never worked for me . . . and the few homosexuals I know of who have believed themselves to be straightened out, even married nice girls and have had children—have all slunk back down the lavender trail and have been sicker and more unhappy . . . and worse degenerates than ever, because they are now *sneaking* their thrills. They are not honest with themselves and their lives are miserable. I believe that if you are queer and didn't do anything about those homosexual tendencies before they took a strong hold on you . . . that the best and only thing to do is to accept it and live with it the best way you can without hurting others. Every life has its problems, and life at its best isn't too easy . . . so, live it the best way you can. Who knows what's *normal* anyway . . . to each his own.
