THE FRAUDS, Michael Hastings. The hero is a colored boy who is seduced into homosexuality and becomes a Christian Science preacher. While preaching, he tries to seduce a pretty young boy who jumps downstairs and breaks a leg. While recovering from the broken leg, the young boy is seduced by a dirty old man, etc., etc. \$4.50

GAME OF FOOLS, James Barr. A hard-hitting drama of four homosexuals brought into violent conflict with their community - how they faced obstacles and powerful pressures. \$5.00
