THE MONTROSE ACTIVITY CENTER

The Gay Community Center was established on December 8, 1975 by leaders of the gay & lesbian community. One year later, the name was changed to Montrose Activity Center, also known as "MAC", to obtain "501c(3)", nonprofit charitable status under U.S. tax codes. Over the years MAC has become a "community center without walls," as it provides or has provided shelter for such groups as Houston Gay/Lesbian Pride Week, the NAMES Project-Houston, the People With AIDS Coalition, AIDS Equity League, Houston Organizing Committee for the March on Austin, Team Houston, Gay/Lesbian Student Association at U of H, the Pride Awards, Montrose Activity Center Credit Union and the Gay & Lesbian Hispanic Unidos.

While the concept of a "community center without walls" is indeed futuristic, and has maintained MAC as a stable entity, MAC's Board of Directors are working to establish a physical presence; a building with desks, chairs, meeting rooms and offices. 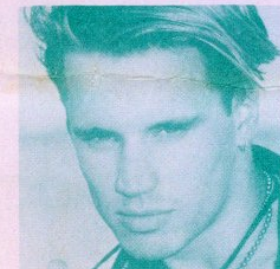

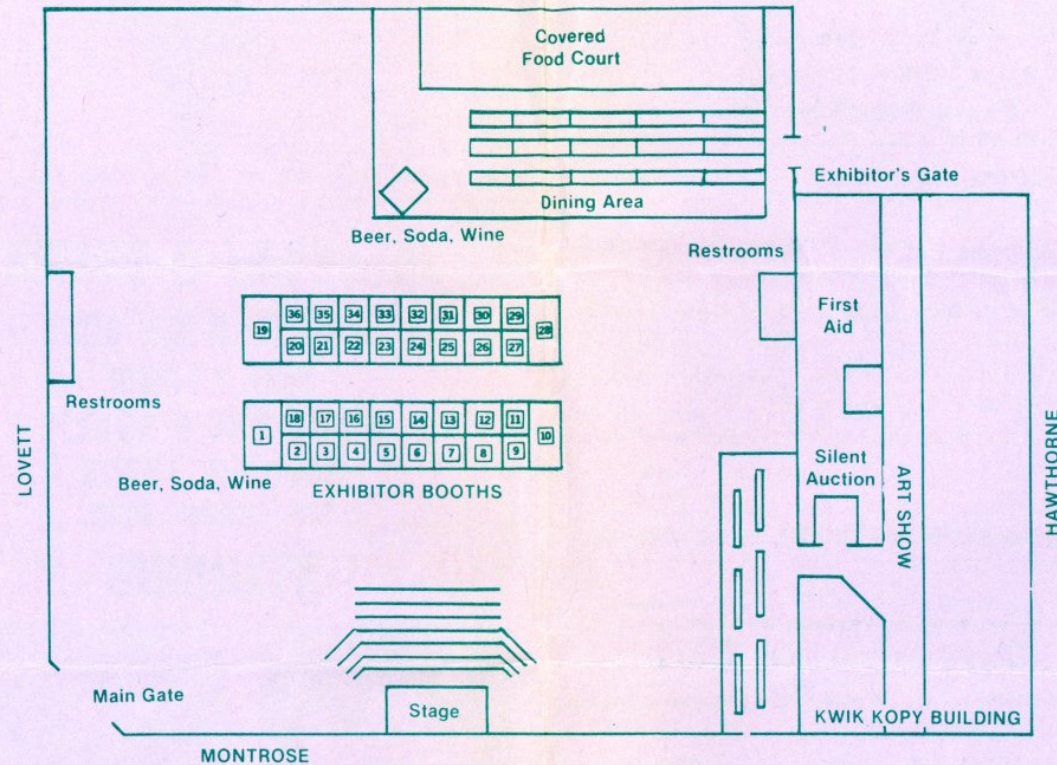
