Wicked Comedy Offers An Obscure Look at Happiness

Raindrops on roses and whiskers on kittens, murder and rape and a pedophile's smitten; old ladies' boobies and kids masturbating...these are a few of Todd's favorite things. Yes, in *Happiness*, writer/director Todd Solondz has found a way to take the most depraved, depressing and disgusting characters and make an even more wicked comedy than his last darkly hilarious hit, *Welcome to the Dollhouse*.

A fragmented tale of nearly a dozen characters, the film's opening features the pathetic breakup of two timid losers, Joy (Jane Adams) and Andy (Jon Lovitz). It only takes moments for the scene to climax in one of the cruelest soliloquies ever captured on celluloid, thus setting the get-ready-to-be-shocked tone for the remainder of the movie. In fact, many theaters actually have warnings posted that the content is extremely mature and no refunds will be given after the first fifteen minutes. Heck, that alone should be enough to get you in line for tickets, but there is much more to the story.

To make matters worse for poor Joy, her seemingly perfect sisters Trish (Cynthia Stevenson) and Helen (Lara Flynn Boyle) do little to hide their pity toward her. What Joy doesn't know is that her sisters are really worse off than they seem. Trish's therapist husband, Bill (Dylan Baker), has a penchant for homosexual activities with 11-year-old boys. Meanwhile, Trish seeks constant reassurance of her husband's love. Helen has become a famous writer, but secretly desires the excitement and danger of becoming involved with her obscene phone-calling stalker. The caller turns out to be her boring next-door neighbor, Allen (Phillip Seymour Hoffman), who has an admirer of his own in across-the-hall neighbor Kristina (Camryn Manheim).

Adding a few more than six degrees of separation to the plot, Allen is also a patient of Bill's. Throw in the topsy-turvy relationship of the three sisters' parents (Ben Gazzara and Louise Lasser) and an aging seductress (Elizabeth Ashley) and you've got enough characters and plot twists to fill two movies, let alone a single two-hour one.

Fortunately, Solondz creates such a disarming tone from the very beginning that I eagerly anticipated every new revelation, even if some of the characters are ignored for good portions of the movie, making for some uneven pacing. The plot goes off on tangents that seem irrelevant, but eventually get resolution, so most are forgiven. The performances of the ensemble are stellar, with each character exhibiting genuine malaise from under their masks of happiness.

Stevenson's portrayal of the ideal housewife is filled with Stepford perfection, a fitting complement to the disturbing performance of Baker as the multifaceted, brooding boy lover. Adams is incredible as the naive, fragile Joy. The growth of her character is evident, although only slightly, as she emerges more unscathed from the movie's circumstances than is expected. As sweaty Allen, Hoffman once again risks being typecast as the perennial weirdo, mainly because he's just so darn good at it. Somehow, he manages to come across as sympathetic, despite his actions. Another true standout is child actor Rufus Read as Trish and Bill's sexually curious son. His interactions with Baker are full of raw intensity and startling honesty, assuredly foreign to many fathers and sons, especially given the subject matter of their conversations. Oh, and did I mention Marla Maples? She's in there too, complete with the requisite divorce punch line.

Beyond the actors and their performances, the eeriest charm of the film is its music. During the most distasteful, shocking events or the brutally honest conversations between the characters, the score is as happy and syrupy as that of any *Leave it to Beaver*-esque, wholesome family sitcom. In contrast, moments of tenderness are marked with somber, foreboding melodies. Creating such an audio-visual oxymoron gives *Happiness* even more edge than the content alone.

The subject matter is definitely controversial, so do be warned. I actually saw people leave halfway through. However, it is most assuredly worth sitting through for the final scene which sums up everything nicely and gives you plenty to discuss on the ride home. It is likely to be the most provocative movie I have seen this year as it dares to go where most films never do, into the deep recesses of people's minds, darkness and all.

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The Pitchfork Disney
Is A Perfect Halloween
Theatre Experience

"...from things that go bump in
the night, preserve us."

- old Scottish prayer.

You may want to mutter this little prayer under your breath as the lights go down for Stages Repertory Theatre's production of Philip Ridley's *The Pitchfork Disney*, because I promise you, you're going to need it. From the moment the lights go up on the spectacular set by scenic and lighting designer Thom Guthrie, which often gets applause on its own, there is a sense of dark foreboding, if not downright terror. First, meet the twins, Presley and Haley Stray (Jim Parsons and Shannon Emerick.) Something is not right here. Presley and Haley are obviously adults, but they think, speak and even move like children. They sit on oversized furniture and eat chocolate. They chatter endlessly about the most banal trivialities, laced with childhood fantasy. Or is it fantasy? Immediately, the play moves the audience into a most uncomfortable sensation. What is real? What isn't? How can you tell?

Deprived of any signposts of reality, you are left with nothing to hold on to. It's the scariest, most dangerous roller coaster you've ever been on, and there's no safety bar. Either you hang on, or you're thrown out. It's the most primeval of fears, the fear of having no control over your own survival. The twins natter on about nuclear winter and wild dogs, and their mysteriously absent parents, while the sense of helplessness grows. Haley is prone to fits of panic, which Presley obligingly controls with sedatives. Periodically, she must be soothed; she naps sporadically.

Enter Cosmo Disney (Alex Kilgore), a nightclub "entertainer," who Presley rather foolishly invites in off the street. The twins appear to have no real human contact beyond each other, and Presley is rather taken with Cosmo. From here, the stakes are raised to unimaginable limits. It is

understood that from this point on, anything can happen, and that is not a good feeling. There is probably nothing more terrifying than our own imagination. I won't give away any more of the plot, except to say there really isn't one. You are simply taken for a ride, albeit a psychological one, and the effect depends upon your willingness to go along for it.

Playwright Ridley is British, and *The Pitchfork Disney* premiered on London's Fringe (the British version of Off Broadway) in 1991. It has since gone on to become something of a cult play in Europe, where audiences often attend in costume, as with *The Rocky Horror Picture Show*. He has written two other plays in this genre, as well as the screenplays for *The Krays* and *The Reflecting Skin*. He also writes children's books. He certainly has a deep understanding of a child's psyche, a bizarre combination of *A Clockwork Orange* and *Winnie the Pooh*. Presley and Haley, though adults, have that essentially egocentric approach to the world around

them that is normal in three-year-olds. Everything that happens, happens to them.

I chatted briefly with the cast after a performance, just to get their impressions of the play — and also to make sure they were acting. I didn't like the idea of those characters running around loose. They seemed fairly normal, for actors, so I relaxed a little. I asked them what they took away from this play. "Tension," said Emerick (Haley,) "and exhaustion. Even though I spend most of the second act asleep, I leave the theater drained." Kilgore's (Cosmo's) answer was "Fear. I realize that throughout the run I've had a vaguely uneasy feeling; a feeling of fright. I haven't slept well." Parsons (Presley) couldn't really pin it down. "I try to separate it," he says. "I have that [horrendously lengthy] monologue at the end of the second act, and I have to pretty much blank everything out to do that." They all have different opinions of what the play is about. "Everyone asks us what happened to the twins' parents, and we all have our theories, but we don't want to say."

Director Rob Bundy doesn't think the

play carries any strong philosophical or political message. He feels it's more about fear, both personal and universal, and I would have to agree. This goes deeper than sociological surface, this goes to the primitive bone. *The Pitchfork Disney* is also quintessentially British. There's something inbred in the British character that conjures up this flight of fancy. I'd be hard-pressed to imagine an American playwright writing this. Maybe a dark, dark Nicky Silver.

So, if you're looking for a Halloween alternative to the usual party scene, or you're looking for something to do before the party begins, consider *The Pitchfork Disney*. Go in costume, make a night of it. The performance is over by 10:30 p.m. at the latest, just in time to make an entrance at your favorite watering hole, so go ahead — do something different. You won't be disappointed.

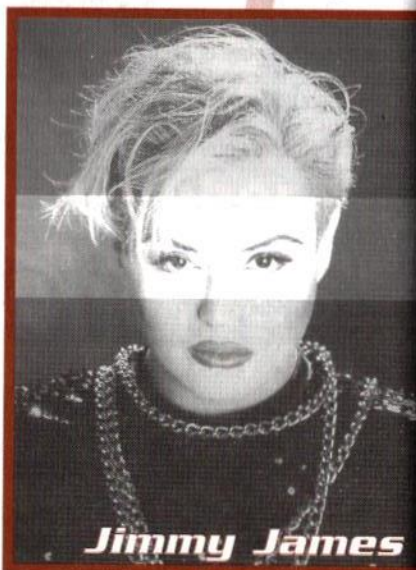

Dance history buffs are always searching for the perfect CD compilation to define the history of dance music, and especially, a particular period. If you are one of these music fanatics, be sure to check out Tommy Boy's new 4-volume series, *The Perfect Beats: New York Electro Hip-Hop + Underground Classics 1980-1985*. This compilation pulls together one of the better assortments of trinkets from the post-disco era that I've seen in a while. In all, there are 58 tracks, each igniting one memory after the next from a time when club music was anything but redundant. Songs like "Don't Go" (Yazoo), "Bostich" (Yello), "Dirty Talk" (Klein & M.B.O.) and artists like Peter Godwin, Siedah Garrett, Xena, and Peech Boys rekindle moments from a period when dance music really was in a different league - a great time for dancing!

One of the period's defining groups, no doubt, was **Soft Cell** (Mark Almond and Dave Ball) with their mega-hit "Tainted Love." Fans will reel with delight over Mercury's release of Soft Cell's "The Singles." This brilliant collection chronicles the group's amazing discography from their first single, "Memorabilia," all the way through "Down In The Subway" and all stops in between.

What do **Kimara Lovelace's** "When Can Our Love Begin" and **Urban Soul's** "Show Me" have in common? (Besides the

fact that they were both number one records.) The answer? **Roland Clark**. A prolific lyricist, Clark has written for such acts as **South Street Players**, **Ceybil Jefferies** and **Chanelle** in addition to his own chart-toppers, many of which he performs himself. His debut album, *My Urban Soul*, will be out on November 30 and it is oh so sweet! The album is almost a greatest hits, featuring gems like "Until We Meet Again," "Set Me Free" and "Love Is So Nice," as well as three new songs: "Holdin' On," "Jump Into the Water" and "Don't Go Away." STONEWALL DEMOCRATS LAUNCH GOTV CAMPAIGN

1,000 Gay Democratic Voters Targeted

HOUSTON - Stonewall Democrats of Houston have launched an aggressive gay GOTV (Get Out The Vote) campaign expected to identify 1,000 gay/lesbian democratic voters. As part of the campaign, Stonewall Democrats will actively encourage voter participation and track the success of the effort. The move is part of a long term initiative to establish a considerable base of support for the 2000 campaign. "Stonewall Democrats has made a commitment to deliver votes for our democratic friends. Our candidates have stood by our issues in the legislative process and have been on the front-line of the Republican attack on gay/lesbian supporters," said Harris County Democratic Party Secretary Francisco Sanchez, Jr.

Stonewall Democrats is in its infancy in the Houston area and came into being through the efforts of a working group of gay/lesbian Democratic leaders. The national organization, the Stonewall Democrats Federation, was founded earlier this year. "The Democratic Party is our political home, by far. The democratic record on important issues to our community is longstanding. The increasing pressure from far right Republican groups, along with their recent name calling and hate-mongering, needs to be countered," stated Sanchez.

As part of the program, Stonewall con-

ducted a successful voter registration program in hopes of attracting new voters to the political process. A voter education component has also been set into motion and has partially brought attention to the Mauro for Governor campaign.

Both gay and lesbian Democrats are being asked and encouraged to pledge their vote for democratic candidates on November 3rd. Stonewall Democrats has set up a phone line to accept pledges from voters who are committed to supporting the Democratic Party in the upcoming general election. "As a new organization, Stonewall dove right into this project. The Christian conservatives are estimated to have fifty-thousand voters on their rolls in Houston. We need to take an aggressive role in identifying just as many gay friendly voters in Harris County to offset their influence and have a greater role in local decision making," said community organizer Grant Martin.

The AIDS TroubleFund provides emergency and temporary financial assistance to those on disability who are monetarily unable to meet basic needs and obligations such as rent, utilities, eye exams and eyeglasses. Due in part to the

significant drop in AIDS related deaths last year, spending in 1998 has increased substantially for the fund. Their client base exceeds 1,300 members on disability and 1999 is expected to add considerably to that list.

The secondary beneficiary, Steven's House, an intermediate care facility, operates 24 hours a day. The facility assists persons living with AIDS. Services are free of charge and their around-the-clock staff provides meal preparation, hygiene, exercising and helps with compliance with medications and appointments.

EPAH is one of Houston's oldest charitable business organizations and it is the first time it has sponsored at this venue. A thirty minute show is scheduled to take place during the event. Military attire is encouraged but will not be required to attend. Love Is The Devil A New Kind of Horror Flick

Sometimes, the classification 'art film' is more accurate than others. *Love Is The Devil* is an art film, a film about art. Actually, it's about the nature of one particular artist. One whacked-out, creepy, and in his own unique way, disgusting gay artist: Francis Bacon. Right up-front, some information: I am completely ignorant on Bacon's work, despite the fact that he is considered the greatest artist of the second half of the 20th century (Picasso covering the first half). Bacon (1909-1992) painted highly charged, emotionally extreme portraits of the human figure, often depicted at times of serious duress. If Bacon's life was anything like it is portrayed here, it is a reflection of his tortured canvases. I, like his lover and muse, George Dyer, would be reaching for the razor blades and ZANAX, too! This movie is like Bacon's work, emotionally disconcerting while creating a sick fascination by watching it. Welcome to an hour and a half of rubber necking at a wreck that's difficult to look away from. My Minnesota friends would say "yisshh." I'd pretty much have to agree.

The film opens with George (Daniel Craig) taking a lethal cocktail of booze and pills at the same moment that Francis (Derek Jacobi) is being introduced during an event at the peak of his career, a retrospective of his work mounted at the Grand Palais in Paris. Just as he dies and falls to the floor, we are transported seven years in the past as George falls through Bacon's studio skylight in a botched burglary attempt. Bacon, hearing the commotion, comes to the door, sizes up the lean, sexy intruder, and says, "Take off your clothes and come to bed and I'll give you anything you want." Here is where common wisdom would say Bacon began a destructive descent by becoming involved with a petty

criminal. In fact, naive George has actually fallen into the spider's web. It becomes painfully evident that Bacon will eventually destroy him.

The film is shot in maddening "artsy" fashion. Lots of fisheye lenses, skewed angles, exaggerated coloring and perspectives. The director, as it turns out, is himself a painter. Bacon's group of artist friends and drinking buddies are grotesquely portrayed. Their poisonous whispers, part jealousy and destructiveness, only add to his life's bitterness and help display the corruption slowly eating away at his soul. I was impressed by the fact that the film

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didn't preach an emotional response to Bacon's life. You are free to see him as a dark genius or a flat-out worm. I choose worm, and that makes George's soul the apple that Bacon chews through.

Bacon draws George into a life of sadistic sex and frightening verbal abuse. George may be dominant in bed; burning Francis with his cigarettes and scarring him with his belts, but Francis scars George's dreams with revolting images of filth and disgust.

Derek Jacobi manages to portray Bacon in a heartless Quentin Crisp-like fashion. Tenderness is not an option. At a crucial moment prior to his suicide, George says "Francis, I love you." Jacobi spits back, "Where do you get your cliches, George? Television?" Jacobi gives us a completely self-absorbed character, quite unflattering, yet given to fascinating insights and haunting journal entries. Somehow, the brilliant Jacobi finds a way to make the monster human. Perhaps he isn't truly a monster, it's only what he does that is monstrous. Jacobi takes a quiet moment of Francis' morning bathroom rituals and visually encapsulates the character in a silent two minute segment. The disdained glare in the mirror as he uses shoe polish to disguise the gray hair, as he shaves, then applies face powder and mascara. This is the blending of masculine and feminine into some disturbing hybrid. Francis tarts up his face with heightened artifice much like he does the extremes in his life and art.

Daniel Craig as George Dyer doesn't

get to say a lot but his tortured face conveys what Bacon has wrought. His initial simplicity is altered and becomes a series of horrifying nightmares. Anguish and alcoholism can be one-note portrayals by some actors. Craig has a whole gallery for us to see.

Interestingly enough, for a film about an artist, never once do you actually see a completed portrait by Bacon on screen. The film assumes that you are familiar with the paintings. The director's extreme choices come to represent Bacon's work. It's not the art that's the subject here, it's the artist. The writer/director, John Maybury, is a graduate of Derek Jarman films like *Caravaggio*, about another homoerotic artist. The dark images of that film hinted at *Heaven's Angels*. Maybury is aiming in the opposite direction.

Films about art are iffy prospects at best. This year's *Wilde*, another British export, missed the mark in its rendition of Oscar Wilde, the author with far too many words. *Love is the Devil* succeeds by recreating Francis Bacon the painter through engrossing imagery. It's just that the "engrossing" happens to be so "gross." I can't deny the excellent performances and amazing cinematography. This film obviously speaks to the psyche that held the brush. If you know or want to understand Bacon's career, see this disturbing film. But beware, I, like George after repeated exposure to these images, did not sleep very well afterwards and followed the experience with a long, cleansing shower.

Ranting & Raving

Belle, Book and Candle

Come Halloween in the Linthicum home, none of us were more captivated by the holiday than my Mother. Ours was the house on the block where children would flock for truly choice trick or treat candies. While other households tried to pass off rolls of pennies, stale popcorn balls and those wretched, neopolitan-striped chewy things, Mom would dump huge handfuls of *Snickers* bars, *Pixie Sticks*, *Smarties*, *M&Ms* and *Blowpops* into every bag.

My brother and sister and I never ventured out for Halloween trick-or-treating. The best candy on the block was literally stock-piled in our own pantry and we always attended the Swaney family's yearly Halloween party. We never missed the Swaney party because receiving an invitation to the gathering was the 7-year-old's equivalent of being asked to a state function at the White House. After being laborously outfitted by our Mother, in costumes rivaled only by *Disney*, we would be whisked off to the all-night soiree and our parents would return home to watch TV in peace.

In 1976, I begged to attend the Swaney party dressed as a baton-twirling majorette. The concept raised eyebrows. My brother and sister were clearly not amused at the prospect of attending the function with their precocious, cross-dressing, younger brother and Dad nearly required hospitalization when presented with my forward thinking concept. Non-plussed, good old Mom set to work immediately, creating a figure flattering hot pant and vest set in ice blue lame coupled with white bobby socks, tennis shoes and turtleneck.

On the evening of the party, I sat patiently while Mom applied blue eye shadow, pink blusher, red lipstick and a shoulder length, dirty blond Eva Gabor wig. It was only when she had stepped back to admire her handywork that the faintest hint of color drained from her festively flushed cheeks. For without the baton, I could just as easily have been mistaken for a plump and sassy, hard-as-nails hooker with just a little too much spring in my step. I demanded to carry with me the cosmetics she had used (for touch-ups) and sauntered out to the car where I waited for one of the gentlemen to open my door.

At 8:00 we arrived at the Swaney home. My brother and sister ran ahead and into the party before I was even out of the car and I stood alone on the sidewalk, powdering my nose, when I realized I had left my baton in the car. By 8:15, I had been to the bathroom for 'touch-ups' some six times. By 8:20, my mother had been called. The very Christian Mr. and Mrs. Swaney couldn't imagine why I had been sent to their home dressed as a prostitute and the youngest Swaney son had expressed a very un-Christian interest in, "the pretty blond girl." Not surprisingly, we were never invited back to the Swaney Halloween party again.
